Healthcare Fraud Alert

STOP OPEN ENROLLMENT FRAUD

During Open Enrollment, we see an increase in scams targeting Medicare beneficiaries. Senior Medicare Patrol would like you to beware of the following scams:

- ❖ Phone calls from people claiming to be from Medicare or the Federal Government asking you to verify or update your Medicare or Social Security number.
- ❖ An agent using misleading or high-pressure sales tactics to get you to enroll in their plan.
- ❖ Representatives that come to your door, uninvited, or call you if you are not already a member of their plan.
- ❖ Someone offering you cash or gifts for switching to their plan.

To avoid becoming a victim, hang up the phone if you receive a phone call from someone claiming to be from Medicare or Social Security. Call your local SHIP (State Health Insurance Assistance Program) if you are unsure about a plan or need assistance choosing a plan.

OPEN ENROLLMENT is from OCT 15 through DEC 7

If you think your Medicare number or Social Security number has been compromised, or you have been enrolled in a plan without your permission, or you have questions about these scams, call Senior Medicare Patrol.
