

## Qualifications for Veteran Housing

- 1. Proof of Veteran Status: DD2.14 / Military ID / Proof of Service
- 2. Length of Service minimum of 180 days/Honorable Discharge
- 3. Proof of Homelessness/Risk of losing housing
- 4. Must be alcohol and drug free (Rehab references will be required if not)
- 5. Must be willing to work a case plan/Counseling/Budgeting/Work Readiness
- 6. Must be eligible for VA Health Care Services
- 7. Must be able & willing to work

Project 4 Hope provides transitional supportive housing and access to supportive services in order to ensure that veterans have a place to live with comfort, dignity, and hope as they work towards financial stability and independence.

Our Veterans Community provides veterans with single-room occupancy housing and supportive services aimed at creating a goal-oriented, nurturing living environment. This Program is designed to address the unique needs of veterans striving for stability and growth, offering the flexibility to establish a long-term residence or utilize the Program to explore more independent housing solutions in the future.

To address the wide range of root causes surrounding housing instability, this Program offers support to veterans who may require assistance with behavioral health, employment, entitlements, and financial stability, ensuring comprehensive care for a broad range of needs. As such, in our Veterans Villages, residents benefit from a support network that includes on-site behavioral intervention specialists, case managers, peer specialists, employment (and education) specialists, and entitlement specialists for assistance with budgeting and navigating benefit systems. These services are provided at no cost to the veteran.

While the Program is available to veterans for 6 months, and up to 1 year, it serves veterans who need temporary support as they work to overcome current barriers. Veterans with shorter-term needs can use supportive services to address challenges, build skills, and transition out of the Program when ready for greater independence. This stable, structured environment aims to help veterans achieve self-sufficiency and exit the Program equipped for independent living.
