01 ARRIVAL TOWN SQUARE

01a Driving Footage

Sometimes the less planning you do, the better the outcome. That was the case this past Tuesday afternoon, when we decided on the spur of the moment to go over to Town Square Las Vegas, grab a bite, and just soak up the atmosphere at this local gem. [DJI_0376]

We're all creatures of habit, and we all have our favorite places to park, don't we? I always go around to the far south side of the property - and considering where we'll end up tonight, it's gonna work out perfectly.

01b Arrive Sickies Garage

We have featured Town Square a few times on our channel. It's a huge, 100-acre shopping, dining, office, and entertainment complex, located on Las Vegas Blvd, just a mile south of the Strip resorts. ...We skipped lunch, so our first stop is going to be for some grub - at Sickies Garage.

...Every time we walk into this place, we are just overwhelmed by the fantastic theming. I'll use that word again: it's immersive!

Note that Sickies can also be accessed from the Town Square Park side...and there's a lovely dining patio out here. ...The vintage gas pumps are a great photo op...and just inside the main doors is some fun branded merchandise for sale.

02 LUNCH AT SICKIES GARAGE

02ab Video-SG Interior

[DJI 0382 arrive at booth; IMG 7079 Dale welcome]

Let's take a look around at the amazing decor in here, while I give you the backstory. Sickies Garage originated in Fargo, North Dakota, where a group of friends with a passion for cars and motorcycles used to hang out together, and experiment with burger creations. They called their meetups "sickies" because they'd call in sick from work to attend. In 2012, they opened a restaurant, and now there are 13 locations across the country.

Their tagline, 50 Burgers and 50 Brews, comes from a menu crammed full of extreme burger creations, paired with a rotating selection of craft, domestic, and import brews from the bar.

03 PUFFY COTTON CANDY

03a Exit Sickies to Park

Dusk comes early these days - it's not even 4:30 yet! ...We have just left Sickies...and can't resist pointing out another great spot for outdoor dining and drinking: Tommy Bahama's Marlin Bar. [DJI_0386 - if you don't like seeing yourself walking, suggest using IMG_7088, 7089, and/or 7441 instead, then go back to DJI for Tommy's]

Heading towards Town Square Park, this alluring window captured our attention, just like a bee to nectar. [DJI_0388 - stop when she smiles at us]

03b Puffy CC General

This is one of 5 locations for Puffy Cotton Candy, a business founded in 2022 that takes cotton candy making to a whole new level. [IMG 7450]

Their cotton candy clouds come in one- or two-flavor sizes, with 8 flavors to choose from. [IMG_7092 in reverse]

But it's the handmade characters that take Puffy over the top, and have made them world-famous. We can't resist, we have to get one!

03c Making a Bunny

You're handed a buzzer that notifies you when your order is ready. But meanwhile, we watched the artist preparing an order ahead of ours...transforming simple spun sugar into a work of art. [IMG_7101]

Here she's preparing the pieces for the face...and by the way, everything on the character is edible. Plus, it's all gluten-free, fat-free, nut-free, dairy-free, and soy-free. [IMG 7102]

This will be the head for a blue bunny.... [IMG 7103]

...and here the face is applied. [IMG 7104]

The ears are spun in a pink color, and applied with adhesive - that's edible, of course. [IMG 7105]

04 TOWN SQUARE WALK

04a Concierge-Playground

We love Town Square. If you're new to it, be sure to stop and visit the concierge for some info. [IMG 7440]

One of the best features is this 9000-square-foot Children's Park, complete with a climbing cube, slides, a trampoline, and more. It's open 7 days a week at 10 am, for kids 10 and younger. [IMG 7437, 7449]

04b Town Square Park

It's twilight by this time, but that doesn't diminish the popularity of the Town Square Park area. If anything, it just adds a magical look to the whole scene. ...This open space, in the midst of all the retail and dining, is meant for fun: play, picnics, concerts and special events.

The Christmas tree is already up and decorated, but not yet lit. The official tree lighting was actually yesterday, November 15th. [IMG 7466, web pic]

04cd Video-Pretty Lights

Adjacent to the park area is a lovely tranquil pond and bridge, great for photos or a leisurely stroll. [IMG_7456]

As the sky gets darker, the lighted figures in the landscape add to the holiday atmosphere - although, this guy is here year-round.

Lighted golden sculptures with holiday themes can be found across the property...and we love the strings of lights across the lanes.

04e Ornament

But the standout is definitely this stunning larger-than-life ornament, across the lane from Town Square Park. [DJI_0391]

Step inside it for a moment, and appreciate what can be achieved with just some metallic panels and a whole lot of fairy lights. [IMG 7470]

04f Walk West

There's the promo for yesterday's festivities. ...Let's take a quick walk to the west side, see what's happening on this end. Fun Fact: This very week, Town Square is celebrating its 18th birthday - it first opened November 14, 2007. Not only is it a central hub for great shopping and dining, but it's also home to great entertainment options. Ahead of us is one of those. [DJI_0392]

We explored Velocity eSports in detail in a video earlier this year. It's a premier esports venue, with a gaming lounge, arcade games, bowling, and a promise to bring you "next level gaming, next level fun". [DJI 0394]

Next door and up those steps is AMC Theatres, with 18 screens...

And around this corner is where Santa will be setting up shop. Or, I should say, he did, as of yesterday! [DJI 0393; pics PIMG 7477, 7478 of AMC;

It's still early in the season yet, but I give kudos to the Town Square folks for making it feel festive in here. This reminds me a little bit of how London does the lanes with strings of lights. [DJI 0395]

05 POPSTROKE

05a Arrive PopStroke

Still with us? We've got one more stop to make before we head for home...and it's this, the coolest mini golf course you could imagine!

Welcome to PopStroke! It just opened here last year, at the south end of the complex, and it positively turns putt-putt golf on its ear. Let's go in.

05b Entrance Area

PopStroke came about in 2019, with the first one opening in Florida. Since then, it's expanded so much that Las Vegas is already its 13th location. [DJI_0399]

When you take a look at this place and all it offers, the pricing is pretty reasonable. There's a lot happening at PopStroke...and we like the recommended sequence of events!

Just next to the ticket counter is one of many bars...and an ice cream shop featuring Blue Bell, touted as the best ice cream in the country for 100 years. [IMG 7510, 7130]

05e Mini Golf Area

The concept of PopStroke was a bold one: to reinvent the classic pastime of mini golf - not with cutesy themes, but with innovative technology, custom-designed courses, playful challenges, and beautifully designed landscapes. Each location has two 18-hole putting courses, suitable for all ages and skill levels. And on evenings like this, playing under the lights - it's a fantastic date night or family activity!
