01b South Point Arrival

Entering from the garage...there's our dinner destination, but we're a little early for our reservation. It's not often that we bring our cameras into the casinos in the evening - so today is a great opportunity to get a feel for how popular the South Point is.

01c South Point Casino

South Point opened in 2005, originally a Coast casino, but purchased by Michael Gaughan the following year. The casino is 137,000 square feet and believe me, it is well-used by both visitors and locals. [DJI_0088]

The sports book is really popular with locals. Often the seats in both the USBC lounge, and these 100 recliners, are all full. [DJI_0085]

South Point is also unique in that they separated the race book from sports, and gave it this really nice area of its own. [DJI_0086]

And over here, a 24-hour-a-day non-smoking poker room. Why play anywhere else? [DJI_0087]
