## 01 TRAVEL-ARRIVAL

# **01a Driving Footage**

On April 28th, the Wynn Las Vegas officially celebrated 20 years in operation on the Strip. We'll talk more about the birthday bash later...but today, after not visiting here in a while, we're going to remind ourselves - and you - just why this place deserves all those awards!

## 01b Wynn Ext-Corner

Out of the car, and down at street level...let's check out the neighborhood. ... Across Sands, the Palazzo...and behind that screen of trees, the Wynn. [IMG\_1096]

Opposite, on Las Vegas Boulevard, there's the Fashion Show Mall...that statement marquee...and the 45-story bronze-tinted tower. [IMG 1100]

Who remembers that first commercial Steve Wynn did, back in 2005, when he famously said: "I'm Steve Wynn and this is my new hotel - the only one I've ever signed my name to."

# **01c Bridges-Sphere**

Before we go in, another big shout out to the pedestrian bridges that make getting across these busy intersections no more than a simple - and safe - sightseeing excursion! [either IMG 1108 or 1109]

And oh, hello there to the Sphere. Hard to remember when this spectacular attraction wasn't part of the Las Vegas landscape. [IMG 1103]

## **01d Strip-Front Lake**

Unlike other Steve Wynn properties, this one doesn't feature a splashy curbside attraction. Instead, the sparkling lake, the trees and landscaping, manage to shield the building itself from the Strip...and entice you to come around for a closer look. [IMG\_1110, IMG\_1092, DJI\_0475]

#### 01e The Waterfall

The mountain was the brainchild of Steve & Elaine Wynn when they were designing the resort. It's 100 feet tall, is planted with 1500 trees, and serves as a huge privacy screen for everything beyond it. The waterfall is one of the most popular picture spots in town. [IMG\_1111, 1088]

Right here is the closest entrance to the Wynn, taking you in through the Esplanade Shops. But today, we'll go in the front door. [IMG\_1112]

## **02 GARDEN-LOBBY**

# 02a Enter-Wynn Garden I

This entrance is just north of the mountain - the valet drop-off, and the closest to hotel registration. A number of articles have been written lately, because of the 20 year anniversary, and they reminded us of all the reasons why Wynn Las Vegas is a superior experience. This atrium is high on that list.

Interior designer Roger Thomas called this "evoca-tecture" - using design and architecture to evoke emotion. Throughout the Wynn you'll find open spaces, natural light, and lots of floral and nature-inspired elements. [DJI 0465]

# 02b Wynn Garden II

The atrium borrows from the Bellagio Conservatory, with large swaths of brilliant-colored blooms appropriate to the season, and fairy lights in the trees to add a little magic. [IMG\_1032 or 1033; then 1034 or 1125]

Our favorite structure in the garden is over here, where you'd land if you had arrived via the Esplanade. This carousel is that bit of whimsy that doesn't seem to belong in a sophisticated casino resort, and yet...it's perfect. [DJI 0469 (skip past me), IMG 1083]

## **02c Lobby-Registration**

Let's pretend we're checking in, and head to Registration. [first part of DJI\_0466]

But wait...this captured Paula's attention, and she struck up a conversation with the craftsman doing the repair. It takes a lot of love and care - not to mention skill - to keep a busy resort looking as fresh and new as the day it opened. Kudos and appreciation to the staff for their efforts! [IMG 1049]

Hotel registration is a large space, featuring marble flooring and earth tones...a statement chandelier...and unbelievably, fresh lilacs here in the southwest desert! [rest of DJI 0466; IMG 1042, pic 1048]

# **02d Lobby Terrace**

All the times we've been here, we never noticed this - there's a terrace, right off the lobby, that leads out to the Lake of Dreams. [DJI 0467]

From this vantage point, you can just make out the Steakhouse patio...the Aft Cocktail Deck...the screen where the show happens...some of those 1500 trees...and a lovely quiet terrace. What a gem of a spot! [IMG\_1045]

#### **03 BARS-VENUES AT FRONT**

#### 03a Bar Parasol

Speaking of Lake of Dreams, there may be no better spot to watch the show than right here, at Bar Parasol. That is some spectacular window right there! [IMG\_1077]

It's not open yet today, but Bar Parasol is probably best viewed from the top down, where you can really appreciate the parasols suspended from the ceiling. The bar offers champagne and cocktails, and caviar-inspired small bites. [IMG 1074 or 1072]

#### 03d Aft Deck Nov 2022

Paula and I enjoyed drinks on the Aft Cocktail Deck a couple of years ago, and I have to say they really nailed that cool yachting vibe out here!

The lake spans 3 acres, and is surrounded by the mountain. Every half hour after dusk, guests are treated to a projection show featuring state-of-the-art sound, lighting, and imagery...plus a 30-foot tall frog who sings and dances. [IMG\_3922]

## **03a Overlook Lounge**

Back indoors, and a peek inside a gorgeous bar that was once called Parasol Up. It's the Overlook Lounge these days, and is an ode to European glamour, with opulent furnishings and jewel tone colors. If it had been open, Paula would have surely stopped in!

## 03b Mizumi-Intrigue

## [Hallway #1]

Our intention today is to walk the whole property, all the public areas...and I don't think we have ever been down this hallway. At the end of it is a Japanese dining establishment called Mizumi. Fresh fish is flown in daily from Japan, and in here, they proudly say, food is art.

Down these intriguing steps - pun intended - is an intimate lounge called The Living Room at Intrigue. It's only open Friday & Saturday nights, but what a setting for a cocktail!

#### **04 CASINO AREA**

#### 04a Casino General

OK, we are finally ready to make our way back from the front side of the resort...and into the casino. Between Wynn and Encore, there are more than 191,000 square feet of gaming - the number varies depending where we look. But, regardless, that makes it the biggest casino in Las Vegas! You can't help but notice the stunning ceiling architecture and lighting in the casino - this is unmatched anywhere else in town.

## **04c Charlies-Sports**

For sports fans, Charlie's Sports Bar is a must-stop. Just check out the views of those wall-to-wall screens in the sports book, from every seat!

#### 04d Red 8

A couple eateries on the casino floor to draw your attention to: Red 8 serves a menu of Asian specialities - noodle dishes, dim sum, and barbecue. Gorgeous room, and definitely red!

## 04e Allegro

Allegro is Wynn's ever-popular Italian casual dining spot - and when we say popular, we mean it. The website says they serve more than a quarter million guests a year! We've dined here many times, most recently in August of last year during our Encore stay.

#### 04f Awakening

[Hallway #2]

Speaking of that, down this hallway is how you reach the Encore resort from the Wynn. We hope you saw our staycation video from 2024, we had a ball at Encore. ...Worth a mention here is the house production show, called "Awakening". It opened in November of 2022, and is an 80-minute spectacular featuring illusions, music, dance, and puppetry.

#### **05 TOWER SUITES HALLWAY**

## **05a Tower Suites Lobby**

[Hallway #3]

One thing we like about Wynn is how all these hallways branch off the main casino, and lead to...well, let's find out. This particular one first takes us to the lobby of the Wynn Tower Suites. [DJI\_0476]

This spacious area has turned into a favorite gathering spot for guests and business travelers, with a vibe that suggests a sophisticated living room... Now this morning, the Tower Suites Bar is serving breakfast items, but at 11 the stools come back out and they switch to a traditional bar. That is the best of both worlds! [DJI\_0478, IMG\_1143]

# **05b Tower Suites Strip Entry**

If you've stayed at Tower Suites, maybe you've come in this way, through this enchanted space filled with tropical plants and koi ponds. No practical reason for this, except to just be surrounded by exotic beauty as you arrive at the Wynn. [IMG 1157, 1158]

#### 05c Tower Suites Room 2020

A few years ago, we stayed at the Tower Suites and did a room tour. At that time, the decor was elegant and classy, with a very subdued and neutral color scheme. [any of IMG\_9082, 9085, 9094]

But one thing Wynn does is constantly update their design! Already, those rooms have been redone with more vibrant pops of color. [2 web pics]

Our view out the window showed the true scale of the mountain - that thing is massive! [small part of IMG 9083]

## 05d Wynn Pool 2020

Just to the left of the Tower Suites front desk is access to the pool deck. [DJI 0477]

During our stay, we spent time at both the Tower Suites pool... [DJI\_0367 or IMG\_9302]

...and the larger and more lively Wynn pool. Both provide a superb resort escape. [IMG\_9303; (optional) end of DJI\_0375 hi to Dale]

#### 05e Tableau 2020

For poolside dining, we have to recommend Tableau. You can enjoy breakfast, brunch, or lunch indoors, our out by the pool...

## 05f Wing Lei-Delilah

Beyond the Tower Suites lobby are 3 other venues of note. Wing Lei is the only Chinese restaurant in the country to have received a Michelin Star. The menu is Cantonese and Szechuan, and the dining room decor was inspired by Chinese jewel boxes. What a setting!

Delilah is the Wynn's answer to the classy supper club. It opened in 2021, and features dining, cocktails, and live entertainment.

# **05g Wedding Salons**

On past the restaurants is the Wynn convention space, and the wedding salons. You have to marvel at the sheer beauty of it, just traveling from point A to point B. [DJI\_0481]

## **06 FAIRWAY ESPLANADE**

## 06ab Wynn Buffet/Buffet April 2023

[Hallway #4]

Yet another hallway, this one called the Fairway Esplanade. First stop is the famous Wynn Buffet - what our connoisseur Paula will say is the best on the Strip. [DJI\_0482, then either DJI\_0484 or IMG\_1164]

Wynn is a superior buffet experience, with 16 separate food kitchens, and cuisine from around the globe. [IMG\_8762; pics 8732, 8795, 8759, 8725]

The seating areas go on forever, and the fresh color and plantings evoke the feeling of dining in a garden. [IMG 8770, 8785, 8815]

Wynn Buffet is a can't miss. [tiny clip of Paula tasting, DJI 0094 or 0098]

#### 06c Sirius XM-La Cave

Now this is interesting! Famed audio entertainment company Sirius XM has partnered with Wynn in this 1700-square-foot studio, where they broadcast music, comedy, sports and more...and we can watch! [IMG\_1167, 1168]

We've never gone into La Cave, but it's an enticing spot. It was just redone last year, and features an exceptional collection of wines as well as shareable plates. [No video, 5 pics of mine, 2 from web]

#### **06d Terrace Pointe Cafe**

Last stop on the Fairway Esplanade is another popular spot, especially right now. It's 10:15 AM on Friday, and the Terrace Pointe Cafe is doing a booming business for breakfast. The cafe is open from 7 to 3 every day, and offers both indoor dining and alfresco, out on the patio.

## 07ab Video-Photos-Esplanade

# [Hallway #5]

Let's talk shopping. This is called the Wynn Esplanade, an avenue of designer boutiques that actually opened with the resort back in 2005. The Esplanade encompasses more than 76,000 square feet of retail, featuring the world's most coveted labels. Tell you what, we'll just settle for window shopping on this trip! ...Now, just to orient yourself, the walkway's other end is out at the Strip, the entry doors across from the pretty lake we saw earlier in the video.

#### **08 WYNN PLAZA SHOPS**

#### **08a Plaza Shops Entry**

## [Hallway #6]

In case you didn't find the brand you were looking for, head this way! In 2018, Wynn unveiled another 70,000 square-foot retail space called the Plaza Shops. As with all the other areas of the resort, original art is prominently featured. The Arrows and Flowers Neon Sign marks the entry to the shops, from the casino side. #### **08bc Video-Photos-Shops General**

The Wynn Plaza Shops is home to 25 upscale retailers, in a two-level, architecturally stunning space. [IMG 1196 or 1202]

Being honest here, a lot of these designer names weren't as familiar to us as the ones in the Esplanade, but no doubt they are exclusive!

...Here at this corner is another art piece, called simply "Tulips". It's made of stainless steel, and coated in colors that pop.

#### 08d Urth Caffe

By far, this is the spot that draws all the patrons in the Plaza Shops - Urth Caffe. Can you even believe the crowd? [IMG\_1211 and/or 1214]

Urth Caffe is renowned for its organic selections - coffees and teas, and lots of healthy living items including vegan and gluten-free. The centerpiece is a hand-tiled fountain surrounding an olive tree. Tell you what, whatever they're selling, everybody is buying!

## 08e Out to Strip

As we head down from the second level to ground floor...hey, there's the Strip. [IMG\_1219]

We are about a block further north than where we started this morning, just past Wynn's main driveway...and, here is the direct entry from the Strip into the Shops. It has a long frontage along the east side of Las Vegas Boulevard. In fact, it actually spans the space between Wynn and its sister property, Encore.

## **08f Corner Property**

Some of you may wonder how a huge 35-acre parcel, right along the resort corridor, remains undeveloped - how can that be? Turns out the land belongs to Wynn, and in fact was once envisioned as a new expansion called "Wynn West". There is an active building permit that extends to April of 2026...stay tuned, we'll see if anything happens with it.
