The Georgia Solar Farm Summit brings together farmers, solar developers, utilities, policymakers, researchers, community leaders, and land stewardship professionals to explore how solar energy and agriculture can work together.

AgPV farming practices stack both function and value-add with performance advantage in the field that is able to not only harvest more on-farm electricity to meet growing demand, but also reap multiple community benefits that can support farmers, strengthen farming communities, reenergize local food systems, and conserve habitat.

WHY SOLAR + FARMING

Solar deployment is expanding rapidly to meet growing electricity demand. At the same time, farm communities are facing important questions about land use, agricultural continuity, economic opportunity, and community resilience.

The Georgia Solar Farm Summit creates space for cross-sector collaboration, interdisciplinary cross-pollination, and constructive dialogue focused on syncing solar development with agriculture and land stewardship.

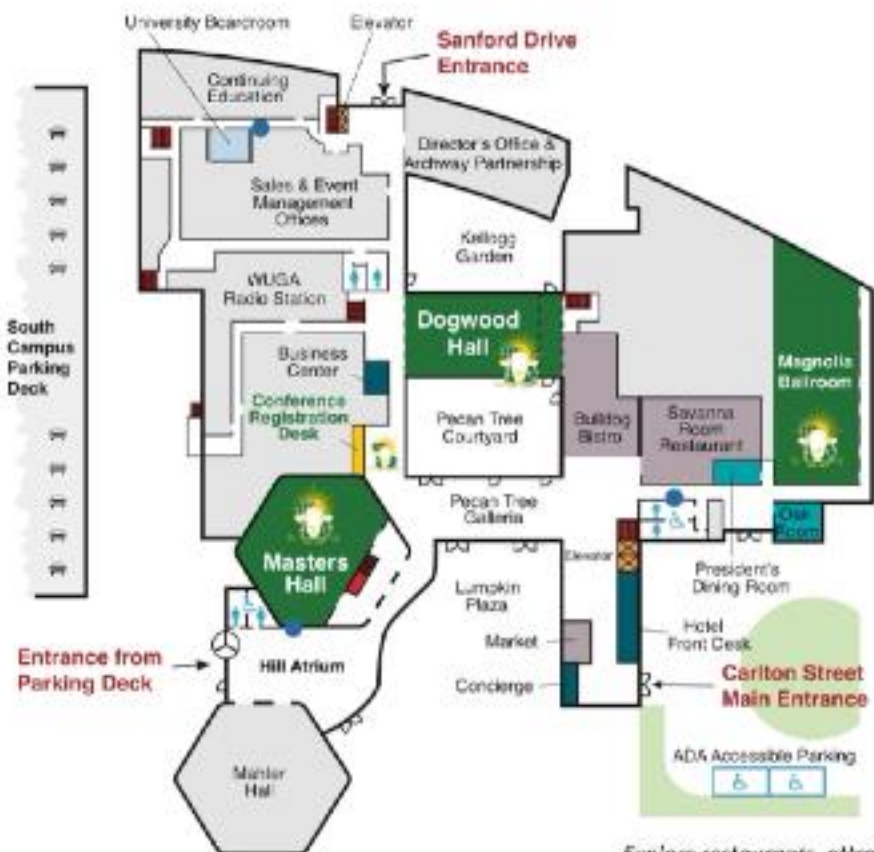
