A Regular Quarterly Meeting of the Trustees of Schools, Township 36 North, Range 13 East. Cook County, Illinois was held at 5:31 p.m. on May 4, 2020 via Zoom Meeting Video Conference Call, in compliance with public gathering limitations and social distancing guidelines set forth in gubernatorial executive order 2020-10.

1. Call Meeting to Order

8. Approval of Revised Investment Policy

Mr. McDonnell mentioned that the Investment Policy is being revised to reflect changes in the Public Funds Investment Act and to add a section entitled "Sustainability" to comply with the Illinois Sustainable Invest Act, Public Act 101-0473, that was effective January 1, 2020. Ms. Washington made a motion to approve the revised Investment Policy as presented, seconded by Mr. Humphrey. Members voted as follows:

9. Approval of Surety Bonds for all School Districts Issuing Bonds During Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2021 and Delegation to the Bremen Township School Treasurer to Obtain Those Surety Bonds

Ms. Gleason made a motion to approve the surety bonds for all Bremen Township School Districts issuing bonds during fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 and delegation to the Bremen Township School Treasurer to obtain those surety bonds, seconded by Ms. Taylor. Members voted as follows:

10. Treasurer's Report

Mr. McDonnell presented to the Board for approval the monthly bank cash balances, investment details by type of investment and a detailed listing of all investments in the portfolio for the periods ending December 31, 2019, January 31, 2020 and February 29, 2020. Mr. McDonnell also presented to the Board for approval the Treasurer's Office Statement of Expenditures for the periods ending December 31, 2019, January 31, 2020 and February 29, 2020.

Mr. McDonnell reviewed the cash balances for each month and mentioned the changes in balances primarily due to normal spend down of funds during these months, as property tax collections will begin again in early March. Mr. McDonnell mentioned that the Federal Reserve had drastically cut interest rates by 50 basis points on March 3rd and by another 100 basis points on March 15th. Both moves were a direct result of the economic impacts of the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic. This will have a significant impact on interest rates going forward, as short-term rates near zero percent.

Mr. McDonnell reviewed the investment details of the pooled funds and explained the various types of investments. Mr. McDonnell stated that he anticipates interest earnings on the pooled funds to decrease respectively, as market rates decline in response to actions taken by the Fed. Currently, the pooled funds have performed well in comparison to other indices, as represented in the monthly average yield graph presented to the Board.

Mr. McDonnell also discussed the Statement of Expenditures as presented for the periods ending December 31, 2019, January 31, 2020 and February 29, 2020. Mr. McDonnell stated that expenditures are within budget as of the end of February.

Mr. McDonnell reviewed the Treasurer's Office Expense allocation for the 2019/2020 fiscal year and explained how the allocation is calculated. Mr. McDonnell also reviewed the Annual Statement of Operations for 2018/2019 and the allocation of interest earnings for January 1, 2019 thru June 30, 2019.

Under other items, Mr. McDonnell noted that the Statement of Economic Interests forms, normally due by May 1, 2020, has been extended to June 1, 2020. Trustees need to make sure that both Trustees of Schools and their respective School Board Member positions are included in the Statement of Economic Interests form.

Mr. McDonnell mentioned that Klein Hall CPA's recently merged with Wipfli LLP. Wipfli LLP was lowest bidder on the Auditing Services Request for Proposal approved by all the Business Managers of our School Districts, as mentioned at the January 6, 2020 Board of Trustee meeting.

Mr. McDonnell explained the overall budget process and discussed several line items that increased or decreased versus the projected actual expenditures for 2019/2020. Mr. McDonnell mentioned that the Preliminary Budget includes Board paid IMRF for all staff members. Mr. McDonnell stated that he conducted a review of several school districts and other Township School Treasurer Offices and determined that this Board paid benefit is common. Mr. McDonnell also mentioned that the actual expenditures for 2019/2020 current year are projected to be under budget.

Mr. McDonnell stated that he was unsure, at this time, but that it will probably be distributed to the State and then allocated to the School Districts thru the State Board of Education.
