A Regular Quarterly Meeting of the Trustees of Schools, Township 36 North, Range 13 East, Cook County, Illinois was held at 5:30 p.m. on October 6, 2025, at Tinley Park High School, Room 110, 6111 West 175<sup>th</sup> Street, Tinley Park, Illinois.

**1. Call Meeting to Order**

Ms. Moslander called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

**2. Pledge of Allegiance**

**4. Approval of Minutes**

Ms. Blackwell made a motion to approve the minutes of July 7, 2025 – Regular Quarterly Meeting, seconded by Ms. Gleason. Members voted as follows:

**5. Recognition of Public**

There were no members from the public in the audience.

**6. Treasurer's Report**

Mr. Grossi gave an update on the following:

- Total cash balances (August 2025) - \$225 Million
- Weighted Avg. Yield (August 2025) – 3.990%
- Weighted Avg. Maturity (August 2025) – 3.01 Years
- Investment by type (May 2025) – 37% Liquid, 22% CD, 5% Corporate, 31% Government, 4% Municipal Securities, 2% Other
- FYTD Interest Earned for the Pool (August 2025) - \$1.5 Million

Mr. Grossi discussed the Cook County property tax delays with the trustees. He stated that he would be surprised if the schools received significant dollars prior to December. He recommended that the school districts closely monitor cashflow until property tax dollars come in. Schools may need to issue Tax Anticipation Warrants to help with cashflow needs in the short term.

**7. Approval of Treasurer's Office Bills (June 2025 – August 2025)**

Motion made by Ms. Blackwell to approve. Seconded by Mr. Welbourn.

**8. New Business**

Mr. Grossi informed the trustees that Bremen 228 just purchased a new building, which they intend to turn into an administrative building. The treasurer's office will likely be moved to this new building, pending results of their bid opening. Based on the projected timeline, the treasurer's office will move around April 2026. An amended lease will be brought to an upcoming trustee meeting.

**9. Adjournment**

There being no further business before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Gleason, seconded by Ms. Blackwell. Motion carried all "Ayes."
