We believe that early school experiences represent a time when social interaction and play will stimulate creativity, exploration, and self-awareness. Free from the pressures of workbooks and rote learning, we provide hands-on experiences and facilitate purposeful play.

Our pedagogy brings together varied approaches to education by design, drawing from Developmentally Appropriate Practice as well as child development theorists and research. We are committed to following best practice in the field of early education and remain aware of the constantly developing knowledge base that is available to us.
