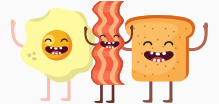

program planning

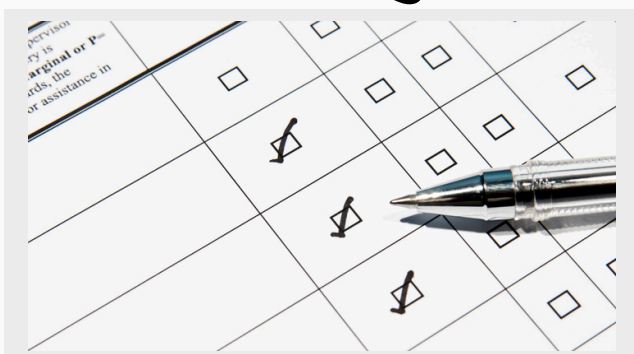
Program Planning is an integral part of each league's grassroots process of recommending and selecting governmental issues for study and agreement in reaching a position.
