A HUGE SHOUT-OUT!

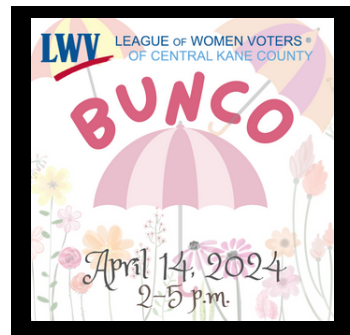

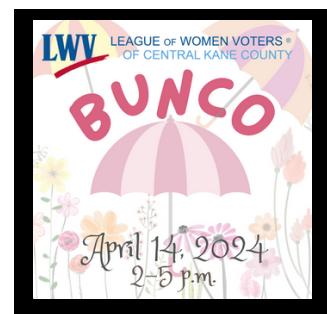
