From LWVUS: A few weeks ago, the US Senate reintroduced the John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act (JLVRAA), which would restore provisions stripped from the Voting Rights Act of 1965 and prevent voter discrimination. Our mission is to empower voters and defend democracy, but we cannot do it alone: we need Congress to support the passage of the JLVRAA. We recently created a template for your local and state League to use to contact your members of Congress and ask them to support the JLVRAA.
