Voter Services is one of our most actively engaged committees and the most volunteer dependent. Thanks to those LWVCKC members who took the time to attend the Voter Service meeting and training done by Kane County elections on December 5th

In November, four CKC League members of participated in a Naturalization Ceremony at Cantigny. You can't begin to describe the feeling of being part of an event like that – you have to experience it for yourself.



Trained registrars will soon be in our local high schools registering young voters to participate in our Democracy. Remember, 17 year olds in Illinois can register *and* vote in the March primary if they will be 18 by the November 5th General Election. If you're a registrar and would like to join the Voter Services Team, watch for available dates and times on our Sign-up Genius form to sign up.



Finally, the Voter Services team has been hard at work lining up candidate forums. Save the dates listed in the "Mark Your Calendar" section above for forums at the Batavia City Hall and watch for details.

Candidate forums need volunteers to greet members of the community; to gathering questions from audience members and review questions for appropriateness. No experience is necessary to volunteer – so don't hesitate to volunteer. Candidate forums is a true all hands on deck event.



Voter Services Legislative Update

Illinois bill SB2123, <u>signed into law August 4</u>, allows 16-year-olds to pre-register to vote, with their registration held in abeyance until they reach voting age—the minimum registration age was previously 17. This change goes into effect January 1, 2024, helping the League to pre-register more voters at our registration drives.
