This weekend we joined the Aurora League for the Aurora Pride Parade, next week is our Third Thursday Member Mixer at the Country House, and LWVIL State Conference,


July we will have Voter Registrar Training because school starts in August and we're off and running again. You know what they say - there's no rest for the wicked.

In the 2025 Legislative session this spring there were over 80 pieces of legislation focused on this topic. We'll join other Illinois LWV chapters in updating the LWVIL position through study and consensus. In collaboration with LWV Elgin Area and LWV Aurora Area we will schedule 3 study/consensus sessions, late August through mid-September, to answer 24 questions. 


