Saturday/Sunday 7:37a; 8:37a (Sat only); 10:37a

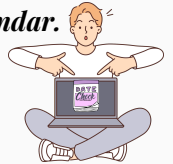

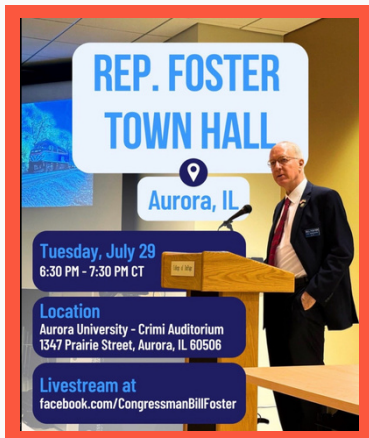


Voter Services Committee

The Voter Services Committee is looking for League members to help with some upcoming projects:

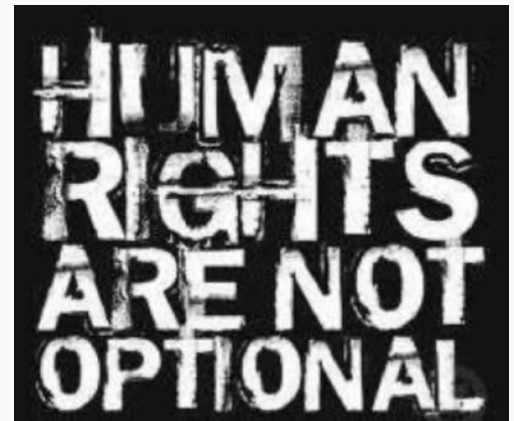
