

**Ron Garnanez** (b. 1952) Developed Ron Garnanez Studio in 2018 which educates and guides his Dine' colleagues who reside on the Navajo Nation into authentic designs and fine art. His expertise and philosophy is steeped in traditional Dine' healing arts through weaving and currently in the fine arts.

The fleece furniture and design are all hand sheered, spun, carded, crocheted base, and felted rugs and poufs.



The wool comes from a rare sheep called the Navajo Churro which came to the Navajo people from the Spanish as early as 1500's in the Southwest.

Garnanez' practice has become known nationally where Shepards from all walks of life become apprentices under his wing.
