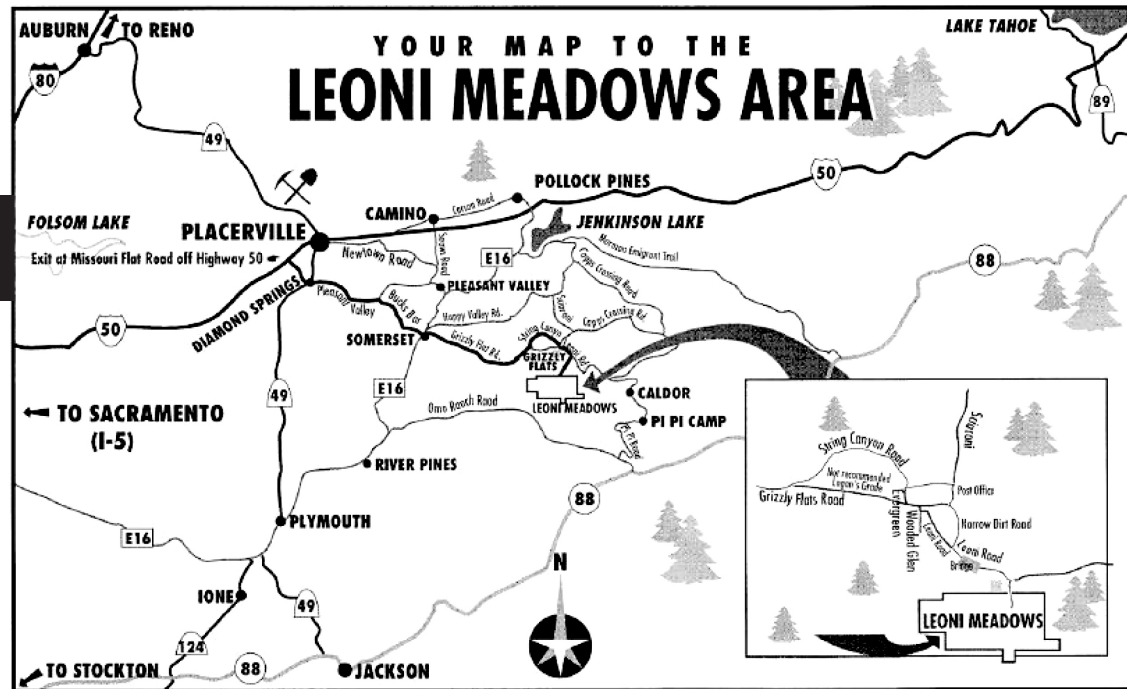

WARNING: Using GPS to locate Leoni Meadows could put you on little - used and badly - maintained roads. Please use the following directions:

Map & Directions to Leoni Meadows Retreat Center
 Go through Somerset on Grizzly Flats Road and stay on this road for 12.2 miles (road name changes to String Canyon Rd. at mile 8.6 - stay to the left). At the stop sign turn right onto Sciaroni Road. There is a post office across the street. Go 0.3 miles to dead end. Turn left (green county road sign points to Leoni Meadows). Road narrows to one lane for 1/4 mile. At bottom of hill keep left. This is Leoni Rd. Continue on pavement for 3 miles to the Leoni Meadows turnoff at a large wooden Leoni Meadows sign. Turn right and go 1 mile past staff houses. The registration lodge is the first large building on the left after the houses. General Information

Cost - Retreat cost is per person and includes two nights' lodging, four meals.
Cabins - Each cabin sleeps eight people. No bedding or linens are supplied. Bathroom facilities are in each cabin.
Dormitory Rooms - There are two large dormitory rooms with bunk beds in the Meadow Inn. No bedding or linens are supplied. Each room accommodates approximately 50 people, with adequate showers available.
Meadow Inn - 67 lodge rooms are available with two queen beds. Bedding and linens are supplied. Room rate is per person, double occupancy.
No EV charge is available. Please plan accordingly.
R.V.s - Electric hookups are available. Restrooms/showers nearby.
Children- No infants or children. This retreat is for women 18 or older.
Leoni Meadows Camp Policies - Pets are not allowed. Alcoholic beverages and smoking are not permitted on the premises.
 All meals are vegetarian (dairy products are served).
What to Bring - Wi-fi is available, but cell phone service is limited
