Integrity: Path

- ❖ Become pure in spirit (1Peter 1:22, Psalm 24:3-4)
 - ❖ Make decision (Daniel 1:8)
 - ❖ Choose to put first things first (Romans 8:29, Mark 7:15, 20-23)

Integrity: Path

- ❖ Determine where the line is, and then stay a safe distance behind it (Matthew 7:13-14, 2Cor. 13:7)
- ❖ Guard your heart (Matthew 6:21)
