

How to Zip a Folder with Multiple Intraoral Scan Files

Step-by-Step for Windows

1. Organize Your Files

Place all your iOS scan files (e.g., .stl, .ply, .dicom) into a single folder.
Example: Patient_JohnDoe_Scans

2. Right-Click the Folder

- Find the folder in File Explorer.
- Right-click on it.

3. Select "Send to" → "Compressed (zipped) folder"

- o Windows will create a .zip file in the same location.
- Rename the .zip file if needed (e.g., JohnDoe_Scans.zip).

Step-by-Step for macOS

1. Organize Your Files

Move all iOS scan files into one folder in Finder.

2. Right-Click (Control + Click) the Folder

Select the folder with your scan files.

3. Choose "Compress"

- macOS will create a .zip file in the same directory.
- Rename the zipped file if necessary.

Tips for Sending to Dental Labs

- Label folders clearly: Include patient name or ID and the date (e.g., JaneSmith_Scan_May2025.zip)
- Double-check that all necessary scan files are inside the folder before zipping.
- Avoid spaces or special characters in file names for smoother upload compatibility.
