



## How to Zip a Folder with Multiple Intraoral Scan Files

### Step-by-Step for Windows

#### 1. Organize Your Files

- Place all your iOS scan files (e.g., .stl, .ply, .dicom) into a single folder.  
Example: Patient\_JohnDoe\_Scans

#### 2. Right-Click the Folder

- Find the folder in **File Explorer**.
- Right-click on it.

#### 3. Select "Send to" → "Compressed (zipped) folder"

- Windows will create a .zip file in the same location.
  - Rename the .zip file if needed (e.g., JohnDoe\_Scans.zip).
- 

### Step-by-Step for macOS

#### 1. Organize Your Files

- Move all iOS scan files into one folder in **Finder**.

#### 2. Right-Click (Control + Click) the Folder

- Select the folder with your scan files.

#### 3. Choose "Compress"

- macOS will create a .zip file in the same directory.
  - Rename the zipped file if necessary.

## Tips for Sending to Dental Labs

- **Label folders clearly:** Include patient name or ID and the date (e.g., JaneSmith\_Scan\_May2025.zip)
- **Double-check** that all necessary scan files are inside the folder before zipping.
- **Avoid spaces or special characters** in file names for smoother upload compatibility.
