50/50 LINE IS USED ONLY FOR PERCUSSION AND COLORGUARD

Cheer and Dance use the same entrances and exits as colorguard.

Unit A is on the floor performing. Unit B is outside the entry door. When Unit A finishes their performance, they move all personnel and equipment towards the exit. When all equipment and personnel are passed the centerline, their interval time stops. Unit A must continue to exit the gym. After the timing judge has recorded Unit A's time, he/she will then signal Unit B to move on to the floor into the red arrows area. As unit A continues to move equipment and personnel towards the exit, Unit B can lay out their floor and equipment, but NOT cross the centerline (THEY MUST STAY ON THE SIDE WITH THE RED ARROWS). Once Unit A is completely out of the performance area, Unit B will be given the signal to finish their set-up. Once they cross the centerline, their interval time will begin.

The 50/50 line varies from gym to gym, and from percussion to colorguard. Please refer to this map for each competition. If you are unsure, please ask a PPAACC representative.

The performance area for this gym is 58.5' from front sideline to back bleachers.
