

HEALTH & SAFETY UPDATE

With the 2022 season right around the corner the following is an update on what COVID protocols may be in place at in-person PPAACC events, and how the information will be released.

2022 Season Shows

Flexibility is crucial this season. The venue hosting the show will have the final decision for the protocols for that show. All of our shows will be held on Kern High School District properties; therefore, PPAACC will enforce all KHSD protocols and procedures. These policies may also change in the middle of the season. Performing groups, staff, judges, and audience members should be prepared for any combination of the scenarios below:

- Groups may need to wear masks in the facility if a mandate is in place.
- Groups should prepare to wear masks both during warm-up and performances should the mask mandate include “during competition”.
- If capacity restrictions for the venue are in place, the show may have limited seating capacity. Performers may not be allowed back in the gym to sit on the backside.
- Audience/staff may need to show proof of vaccination or recent negative test
- All persons inside the gym may be required to wear a mask and/or social distance.

As we get closer to each show, we will do our best to update the information for each competition based on state, county, and district policies. We thank the unit staff members and community members for their patience as we work to get our kids performing again.
