We hope you join us this summer for some



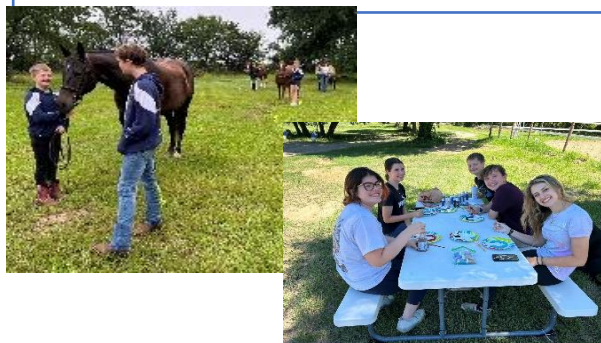

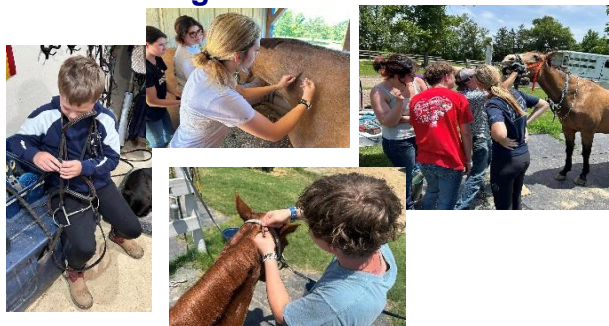

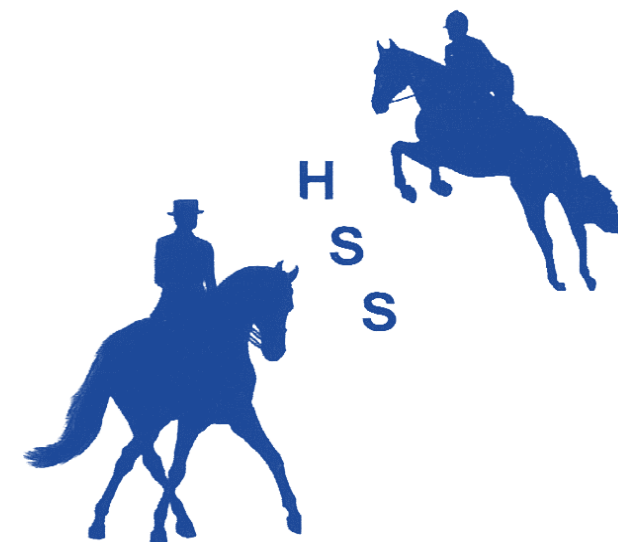

Session 1 - Wednesday June 11 - Friday June 13

Session 2 - Wednesday July 9 - Friday July 11

Cost: \$250/rider/camp

Session 1 - Monday June 2 - Thursday June 5

Session 2 - Tuesday July 15 - Friday July 18

Cost: \$350/rider/camp

Riders must be able to control the horse at the canter or be approved by Amy to attend this camp. Campers will spend time in the saddle working on their position and skills to help them take their riding to the next level. Camp week will be packed with learning on and off the horse. Campers will improve their horsemanship skills, learn about daily horse care, first aid, lunging, braiding, handling, horse shows, and much more.

There will be a HSS horse show (on Friday for session 1 and Saturday for session 2) after the camp that everyone is invited to participate in and show off what they have been working on while also having a chance to win a ribbon.
