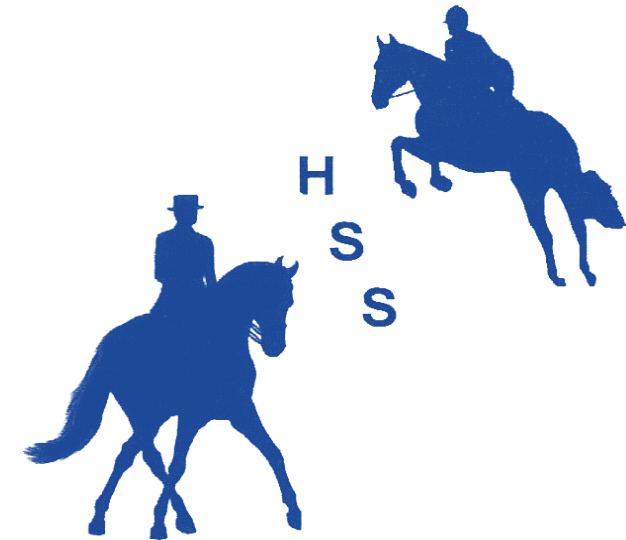

Beginner Horse Camp

Ages 13 and under

Session 1 - Wednesday, June 10 - Friday, June 12

Session 2 - Wednesday, July 15 - Friday, July 17

Cost: \$300/rider/camp

This is a perfect camp for those who are at the walk or walk/trot level. Campers will spend time in the saddle working on their position and skills. They will also work on their horsemanship skills and learn about every day horse care and safety. The horse learning will continue as they get to do fun crafts and games.

There will be a HSS horse show on Saturday after the camp that everyone is invited to participate in and show off what they have been working on while also having a chance to win a ribbon. Each camper will get one free class included with their camp registration.

Dressage & Combined Training Camp

Riders must be approved by Amy to attend this camp

Drop off at 7:00am - Pick up at 12:30pm

Tuesday, June 16 - Friday, June 19

Cost: \$450/rider/camp

This camp is for riders who are solid at the posting trot and can control the horse at the trot while going over a course of poles. Riders must be approved by Amy to attend this camp. Campers will spend time in the saddle working on their position and skills to help them take their riding to the next level. They will learn all about dressage and dressage tests as well as learning about riding a stadium course over poles or jumps. Camp week will be intense with learning on and off the horse. Campers will improve their horsemanship skills, learn about daily horse care, first aid, lunging, braiding, handling, horse shows, and much more.

There will be a horse show starting at 9:00am Friday where each rider will compete in a combined test(dressage & stadium course). This is included with their camp registration. Be sure to invite family/friends to watch and see the progress you've made!

To register:

1) Fill out the registration form and mail it in with a non refundable \$75 deposit (checks to be made out to Amy Becker). Your non refundable deposit and registration form must be received in order to reserve your spot. If the camp has already filled you will get back your deposit or you can be put on the waiting list.

2) The balance of camp is due 1 month before camp. If the balance isn't paid 1 month prior to camp you will forfeit your slot and deposit. If you do not attend camp after paying the balance you will only get your money back minus the deposit if your slot is filled from the waitlist.

3) If you have never taken a lesson at HSS you must take one private lesson prior to your camp so that Amy can evaluate your riding. Be sure to schedule your lesson early before you sign up for camp.
