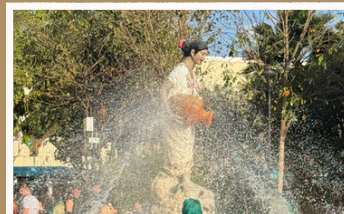
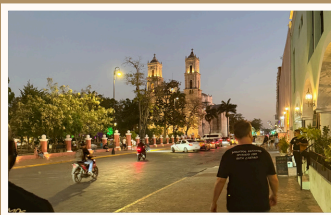

SERVING OUR COMMUNITY

Some of the outreaches we have done over the past year include:

- Cleaning up and prayer-walking the grounds at First Coast Women's Services Clay.
- Planting a garden at Brookdale Assisted Living Facility.
- Christmas caroling and ornament giveaways at Oakdale Rehabilitation and Skilled Nursing Center.
- Providing a craft activity at Brookdale to help residents make Christmas luminaries from mason jars.
- Hosting a New Year's cookie decorating day at Brookdale and providing treats for the residents of the Memory Care unit and all staff.
- Donating \$1,000 worth of infant supplies to the Maternity Closet at First Coast Women's Center and gifting the staff and volunteers with gift baskets to show our appreciation for their work.

In April, a team of our missionaries spent four days volunteering in collaboration with Servant Life Missions and Serve Orlando in Orlando, Florida. We served at the Salvation Army, Rise Against Hunger, Second Harvest Food Bank, Second Harvest Mercy Kitchen, and Christian Service Center.
