Learning is Fun Libraries (LISFL): Hearts for Ukraine is the first European initiative for our library projects. Although Heroes & Heart has conducted overseas projects for Super Justyn's Giveaway and The Blessing Project and have even created in-home libraries in our home base of Las Vegas, NV, this European initiative is the first of its kind for Heroes & Heart. The goal for Learning is Fun Libraries: Hearts for Ukraine is simple. 1-Provide essential items needed for daily survival such as; toiletries, baby wipes, diapers, canned food, etc. 2-To create the young Ukrainian refugees create learn & play spaces for Ukrainian children to access to education and nutrition in a place that makes them feel safe and celebrated.

Three Community Pillars

Pillar 1-Participation: Our Rock, Paper, Scissors (RPS) Tournament (or Tourney) raises money and "stuff" (like toys, snacks, books, school supplies, & diapers) for the kids and families in Ukraine. With our global partners, the hybrid event is both virtual and in-person. Our Live Las Vegas event will be held on Sunday, August, 14, 2022 @ 1 PM PST. Our global participants can choose participate in two ways: 1-By joining us in our Vegas event either virtually or in-person, 2-By hosting their own Tourney on or before, Sunday, August 14, 2022 at 1pm PST.

1. Participants can choose to either pay to enter (Kids/Teens-\$9, Adults-\$19, Families/Teams-\$29, and Businesses - \$39) or donate one of the items listed on the "NEEDS LIST". 




Heroes & Heart has four giveback campaigns:

- Around the World Read-A-Thon
- Super Justyn's Giveaway
- Learning is Fun Libraries
- The Blessing Project

These four events have been sponsored by grant funds and in kind and monetary donations. As a result, Heroes & Heart has served hundreds of kids, youth, adults, and families.

STEM Days: Robotics, Bricks, & Kicks! 2022 will give children, grades K-5, from diverse communities and populations a unique opportunity to explore and experience sustainable science. The setting of the event will occur at East Las Vegas Community Center where a large population of BIPOC families reside and where one will find diversity among languages, cultures, artistic presentations, and people. Moreover, participants will come from varied cultural, ethnic, economic, and age backgrounds. Therefore, having a program of this magnitude is exceptionally unique among the underrepresented communities we are honored to serve. Furthermore, we are excited that the participation of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department will show partnership, positivity, and peace to our attendees. We are confident their assistance with the Sustainable STEM Stations will serve as a bridge to build strong relationships between the children and law enforcement. STEM Days: Robotics, Bricks, & Kicks! 2022 will consist of Sustainable

STEM Days: Robotics, Bricks, & Kicks! 2022 will consist of Sustainable STEM Stations where children will engage in activities involving science, sustainability, and soccer. Each station will have instructors who will provide live demonstrations and step-by-step lessons for 45 - 60 minutes. The lessons will show the children unique ways to help reduce, reuse, and recycle and are based on Nevada Science/Math Standards. In addition to sustainable station rotations, students will write, draw and/or discuss their Sustainable STEM Day experiences. Their learning projects will be shared visually and orally,





providing them with the opportunity to develop their presentation and public speaking skills.

Sustainable STEM Stations:

1. Robotics - Working with our community partner, the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, robotic demonstrations will be presented to the children. Introducing the students to the many functions of robots will be an extraordinary educational experience. Additionally, the students will create their own robots using soda cans. Recycled Robots will be made using materials they can find at home. Turning these materials into a working robots will teach the children how everyday items can be used to save the earth, create a masterpiece, and support sustainable science. Working with members of the National Society of Black Engineers, students will learn robotics through a mindson, hand-on, play-on approach.

2. <u>Bricks</u> - Our community partners will have a LEGO brick drive. As a result, LEGO bricks not being used by children and families will have a new home. This project will encourage the students to give items they no longer use a new life with someone else. They will learn that giving away, instead of throwing away, is a way to save planet earth and help meet someone else's needs. Additionally, using recycled LEGO bricks, the children will experience the joys of science, engineering, and mechanics through the creation of LEGO builds. Community partner, Bricks4Kids, will provide demonstrations and instruction. The children will have the choice to create builds according to their skill level(s). We are confident this sustainable station

will encourage students to explore the topics of recycling, philanthropy, engineering, and solar, all through the power of play.

3. Kicks - A Community Soccer Team will lead our students in making their own soccer balls using newspaper, plastic bags, and twine. This activity will allow the children to recycle and repurpose everyday items, keeping them out of landfills and giving them hours of fun on the playing field. Also, through a fun interactive, students will practice their soccer skills and learn sport science! Excitedly, the game of soccer will be used to show how aerodynamics, physics, and mathematics are important to scoring. Through simulations and sustainable soccer balls, Kicks will allow the children to move, exercise, and experience unique athletic activities. Finally, **STEM** Days: Robotics, Bricks, & Kicks! 2022 will include an array of disciplines and learning modalities. As a result, sustainability, service, sports, science, and speaking will be highlighted. Furthermore, the multidisciplinary activities will be made accessible to all learners in an inclusive environment. We are excited to have students with different abilities both physically and cognitively. Also, their finished projects and visual/oral presentations will be strong indicators of their growth, understanding, and enjoyment at STEM Days: Robotics, Bricks, & Kicks! 2022.



Can you **imagine** a **world** without libraries? Well, the second largest continent in our world, **Africa**, has less libraries than the whole **USA!** Did you know that some kids have never walked into a **library**, or don't know that libraries can exist within their community? **Learning Is Fun Libraries** (LISFL) is a literacy-based global initiative. Across the world, there are more than 617 million children who are not achieving a basic level of education (Unesco 2017). Heroes & Heart seeks to close the achievement gap and nurture a culture of reading by getting much needed reading materials in the hands of children overseas. By 2022, **LISFL** will build the first library overseas and by the end of 2022 build the first library in Gabon, Central Africa.

Opening a library in Africa will be a great first step towards ending illiteracy worldwide.

LISFL is meant to be a safe place. We want kids to be able to read books, play, run around, and eat food in the library. We found many other people doing the same thing around the world. Unfortunately, very few programs are on the continent of Africa. Our goal is to create a literacy tour across Africa and the world, building libraries and stocking them with lots of BOOKS! As a Super Hero for libraries, Justyn wants to be a light for children starving for literacy and a champion of reading. 
