A Message From Our Exalted Ruler

Happy August fellow Elks. Before I expound upon an opportunity before us, I want to frame it with a moment to reflect on a great experience I had at the end of June and beginning of July. I attended the Grand Lodge national convention in Austin, Texas. Pre-retirement, over a 40-year career in public education, I attended numerous national conventions. I represented our state in varied capacities; as a teacher, counselor, district superintendent, a state association president, and as our state deputy superintendent. None of those conventions were anything like the Grand Lodge national convention. The most striking difference was in the exhibition hall. In previous conventions, the halls were filled with potpourri of companies trying to sell you things to make your districts or states “better.” At Grand Lodge, conversely, it was filled with individuals focused on the same things we are focused on; making our communities stronger. Other than a few vendors selling clothing with the Elks logo, it was filled with people like us. They were selling nothing, but instead were SHARING everything they could about their work which made them proud to be an Elk. It was truly inspiring.

The training sessions were informative and helpful, but the networking and conversations with fellow Elks from all across our nation were validating and extremely educational. No one was smarter or better than anyone else, and everyone was there to learn from and celebrate with one another.

One of my favorite statesmen in history is Will Rogers. He once said, “We are all ignorant. We are just ignorant about different things.” These are words to make a person smile - then bow their head a moment, and finally stand all the straighter. For they give us courage, even as they make us humble. They tell us how much we need one another. They show us how each of us has our place and our job to do. They level us all down, and then lift us all up, in eagerness, and hope to learn a little about the lot we don’t know. Said with the easy kindness of a man who at the same time was simple and wise, they are a directive toward our interdependence.

The pride of the intellectual is a Lucifer danger, which in the recent past has led fine minds as far as the betrayal of our country. The know-how of the expert can be, without wider vision, no more than a blind alley. The fixed idea of the opinionated is as dangerous as a blunt instrument. And the complacency of the incurious is a kind of death in life.

But to know how little you know, and to turn - with the friendliness of a Will Rogers - to others, to learn from them, is worthy of the greatest mind and possible to the least instructed. It has been said that, “none of us can do it all, but all of us can do something.” When we enlist others to help us with our tasks in service to our Elks causes, we must remember to seek their input and listen to them. We have to acknowledge our own ignorance, and honor their brilliance. In sharing this vulnerability-based trust, more of us will step up to participate in our worthy causes. I believe people are just waiting to be asked. If you are one of those in waiting, ask to be included.

We must seek, across all barriers of kind, caste, and color, to understand those ignorant of what we know, yet wise in their own ways. We must seek to understand before being understood. Only then will we master the ultimate lesson-how to live and work together in our common home – Elkdom!
