#### **Application Instructions**

#### **Application Guidelines**

Applicant must use the official 2022 application. It must be dated and signed by the student, parent(s) or guardian. Typed applications are preferred. Applications and all supporting documents must be in English.

#### **Completed Application**

Applications must be properly bound on left side with hinges or staples in a 3-hole paper fold. Elaborate binders, clear plastic, and bulky coverings are discouraged. The completed application should not exceed 20 pages.

#### **Employment and Community Service**

List jobs held and community service performed for November 1, 2020 through October 31, 2021. Please list total hours worked, not average hours per week.

#### **Honors and Awards**

In the Honors and Awards section, do not include awards such as Academic Letter, Honor Roll, Perfect Attendance, Scout Merit Badges, Teen of the Month, Top Percent of Class, and Who's Who. This list is not inclusive. Activity sheets are acceptable replacements for the Employment and Community Service section and must be structured identically to the application.

#### **Applicant Essay**

The applicant must prepare an essay of <u>350</u> <u>words or less</u> stating: Role leadership has played in your high school accomplishments, determining career aspirations, achieving these life goals, and preparing for college. **The essay must be dated and signed.** 

#### **Parental Financial Statement**

The parent/guardian must prepare a statement of 200 words or less summarizing the family's obligations and resources. The statement needs

to illustrate the applicant's need for financial assistance and the inability to meet these needs. **The statement must be signed and dated.** <u>Note</u>: Statement may exceed 200 words if parent has been asked to explain extenuating circumstances regarding non-custodial parent (see Custodial Parent) or if there are extenuating

#### **Transcript and SAT/ACT Scores**

medical circumstances.

Include official, complete, current high school transcripts of student grades. Transcripts may be photocopies that bear the original signature of the proper school authority.

SAT or ACT test scores must be included and may be photocopies. If recorded on official transcript, a separate copy is not necessary. Use one set of ACT scores only, or up to two sets of SAT scores.

#### Letters of Recommendation

Include one letter of recommendation from a high school teacher. The letter may cover applicant's ability, work habits, leadership, personality, and integrity.

Include one letter of recommendation from a responsible community member. The person should not be related to the applicant. The letter may cover applicant's participation in the community in-terms of work service, leadership skills, and outstanding recognition.

Letters are to be originals, limited to one side of a single sheet (8.5 by 11-inch) of paper, typed, **dated**, and signed by the author.

#### Exhibits

Attach copies of exhibits of achievement in scholarship, leadership, athletics, dramatics, community service, or other activities, but avoid repetition.

#### Tacoma Elks Lodge 174 Scholarship Guidelines

#### Eligibility

Any student in the graduating class of a high school, or its related equivalent, who is a resident within the jurisdiction of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Tacoma Elks Lodge #174, may file an application. All applicants <u>must be</u> <u>citizens of the United States of America</u> on the date the application is filed.

#### **Application Process**

This application must be filed with the Lodge Scholarship Chairman. Only one application may be filed. The final date for filing completed applications with the Lodge is March 4, 2023.

We require a Social Security number for our records.

After completing this application, make a photocopy for your records. All applications become the property of the Tacoma Elks Lodge #174.

#### Scoring

#### Awards

All scholarships are in the form of certificates of award issued by the Tacoma Elks Lodge, conditioned upon the enrollment of the student in an undergraduate degree program in an accredited <u>US American college or university</u>. (For the first two years of the four-year program, the student may enroll at a two-year college.) Upon receipt of "Verification of Enrollment" form from proper school officials, a check for the amount of the award will be forwarded to the college or university to establish a credit for the student.

#### **Custodial Parent**

If your parents are divorced or separated, answer the questions for the parent you lived with the most in the past 12 months. If you lived with both parents an equal number of days in the past 12 months, you would count the parent who provided you wit the greatest amount of support, financial as well as material. Material things would include cards, clothing, medical and dental payment, etc. If that parent has remarried, you must include the stepparent's information.

<u>Note</u>: If family has divorced or separated within the past five years and the custodial parent has not remarried, applicant must provide financial information of non-custodial parent. If whereabouts are unknown or non-custodial parent is unwilling to comply, please explain in parental statement.

#### **Independent Student**

We will not accept an applicant as an independent student unless the student is or has been a ward of the Court. We require a copy of a Court Document or a Notarized letter from an appropriate Court Agency (Social Services) certifying to such status.
