Jayden was born with down syndrome and was later diagnosed with autism at the age of three. One of Jayden's many challenges has been limited dexterity and fine motor skills. He was unable to use his fingers properly to cut with scissors, tie his shoes and write.

Jayden has been receiving occupational therapy services through the Washington Elks Therapy Program for Children since November 2021 along with outside services and clinics.


Overall, Jayden's development has progressed greatly! He has made amazing leaps and bounds in achieving his goals.


He now utilizes proper hand posture to cut along a dotted line and pick up tiny objects. We have also noticed major improvements with core balance and strength.



There are two telephone museums in our area that have lots of interesting equipment from days gone by. The first one is the Tacoma Telephone Pioneer Museum at 757 Fawcett Ave. S. (brick building on the corner of 9th & Fawcett Ave. S.). The museum is open only on Thursday mornings from 8 am – noon and staffed with former telephone workers. After ringing in, the volunteers will walk you thru the equipment demonstrating much of it. Tour groups are welcome but call in advance. For more information call 253-627-2996.



The second museum is the Connections Museum in Seattle. It's located at 7000 E. Marginal Way S. and is open on Sundays from 10 am to 3 pm. Plan to spend several hours as there is so much to see. The mission of the Telecommunications History Group is to acquire, preserve, and promote the rich heritage of the telecommunications industry and to connect that past to evolving technologies and cultures.
