# *A Message From Our Exalted Ruler*

*Gil Mendoza*



Happy June and beginning of summer (*June 21*) my Fellow Elks Sisters and Brothers:

As I pondered my message for this month, I was struck by the concept that we all are servants to someone. As such, we have the blessing of living and acting for someone other than ourselves. While we primarily target such devotion to our immediate families, there are many who extend this attitude and accompanying action beyond that sacred circle. I almost immediately reflected on people at the Tacoma Elks. From our staff, to our members, there are many who focus their efforts in service to others; if only by sincerely caring about them. If you golf, you observe this in the attitudes and delivery of services by our Pro shop staff and our professional grounds crew. They all go out of their way to ensure your experience is beyond enjoyable. The “value added” they put in their efforts, while part of their training, and modeling they observe in their leaders, is innate in their character. That is probably why we hired them. The same could be stated of the staff in our Urban Elk Restaurant. To a person, they seek to understand you before presuming you should understand them.

I often joke with friends and family that I was raised Jesuit, having attended Bellarmine prep for high school, Gonzaga University for undergraduate studies, and Seattle University for graduate work; having obtained my doctorate there; all Jesuit communities. What I learned through those immersions, was that the founder of that order based its genesis on the concept of “Servant Leadership.” It was the ethos of their beginning (September 27, 1540), and existence, before the term was coined in an essay “*The Servant As Leader*,” (1970), by Robert Greenleaf, having become fashionable in studies on leadership in the early 1990s. He proposed that the best leaders focus on serving the needs of others first. Not surprising, it undergirds what the Elks stands for, and has, since our own beginning in the mid-1800s.

While most of our staff and members are not positional “leaders” in our organization, they all are “leader-like,” accepting their roles as servants to us, our Lodge and the purpose of the Elks. When you reflect on why you come to our Lodge, take some time to consciously give thanks to those who help create the blessings we share, and continue to sustain them. Take a good look at them. You will see the joy and goodness in their eyes, hoping to see it rub off on you; action creating like action; the boomerang game good servants play.

Our Lodge is the incubator for good. Elks Care ... Elks Share. John Masefield, famous English poet and writer (1878 – 1967) knew this concept well, and expressed it through his classic maritime poetry and beloved children’s fantasy novels. He noted, “*The days that make us happy, make us wise.*” Our staff and members understand this. Seek those opportunities to share that legacy of our Elks community. Be the servant for others. You will be the leader as well, and you will keep our Lodge and our mission out front with the community and each other. You will participate in painting our picture as the beacon it can be in goodness and joy.

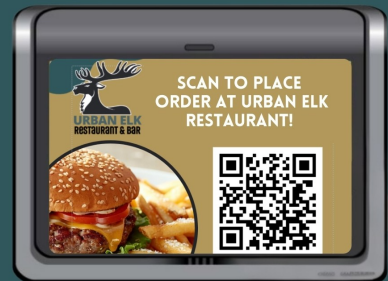

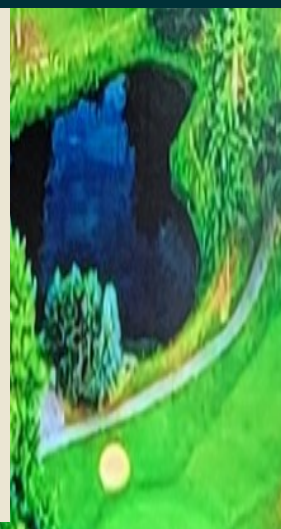
