# *A Message From Our Exalted Ruler*

## Message from our Exalted Ruler

Welcome to August my Sister and Brother Elks. It is the center of summer, working into our Indian summer right around the corner. Perhaps it is the unusual spells of intolerable heat with occasional rain showers to break it up, which cause us Pacific Northwesterners to suffer uncertainty. Compounded with extra duties of child teaching and rearing, without the school system to help, and uncompleted tasks on top of new emergent life-demands, many suffer the schizophrenia of negative, hopeless thoughts that maybe things are as bad as we might imagine. It all adds up to resignation and, in some cases, despair.

I say we take up a simple defense of accepting that **this too shall pass**. Simple philosophy, yet proven effective by our wiser elders preceding us, I think of my step-mother, Betty, who at the age of 95 left us in 2019 with a lucid mind and detailed remembrances of the best of times. Having suffered rheumatic fever as a child, and numerous medical maladies later in life, as a result, she never expressed self-pity. She took her attitude from another famous of our elders, Anna Mary Robertson Moses (1860-1961). "Grandma Moses" medicine, from her memoirs, *"My Life's History,"* describes how a renowned American Folk artist famously began her painting career in her late 70s after arthritis made embroidery too difficult. Completely self-taught she became a national icon for her nostalgic, vibrant landscape paintings of rural farm life. She noted: *"Then Anna was born, so I had four babies to care for. But we got along very nice till the children got the scarlet fever, that was a hard year but it passed on like all the rest."* These two sentences constitute grandma Moses' complete and unabridged account of one of her 92 years.

In brevity, I believe, like Betty, it goes far to explain why they lived into their tenth decades. They were not inarticulate and could describe in loving and minute detail their wedding dresses, a Thanksgiving dinner, a practical joke they and another girl played on someone; but about a hard year they found nothing worth remembering except that *"it passed on like all the rest."*

Nobody can explain genius, so exactly what it is that made Grandma Moses a magnificent painter - my step-mother Betty was an accomplished, self-taught painter as well - no person can tell. But if you want to know why they remained alert, vigorous, radiantly alive into their nineties, mull over the previously stated bit of philosophy.

Beauty, love, laughter and delight are imperishable memories, but all that is important about hardship is that it passes. How right Grandma Moses and Betty were with keen perception. If we could only remember this truth in the hard years, how many spiritual scars and deformities we could escape, and how much more abundant life would be in the years that are given to us. Focus on our blessings and the beauty of our shared lives. Address it as we must, but let hardship slip away into a passing moment, not to be perseverated upon. Celebrate life and the beauty of an Elks life.

## Project description

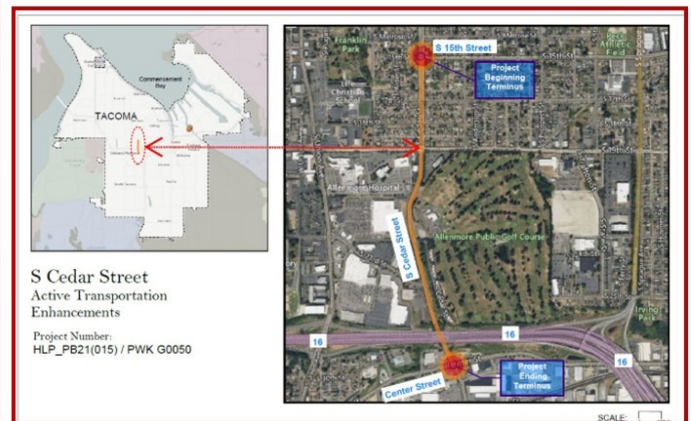
This project consists of marked crosswalk, pedestrian crossing advance stop bars, rectangular rapid flashing beacons, lane width reduction, road reconfiguration, median channelization/turn restrictions, ADA curb ramp retrofits, audible pedestrian signal, bicycle way-finding (signs and markings), buffered bike lanes, green pavement markings, one-way or two-way protected bike lane, sidewalk with curb and buffer, pedestrian countdown signal, bike signal detection, bike box, and engineering investigation re: speed limit & bike ramp.

## Bingo – Eight Years in the Making

In June 2018, a small group of our members started having Bingo on Monday nights in the Lodge room. In these eight years, the same members of our Lodge (minus two people) are still supporting Bingo on Monday nights. This started to promote activities in our lodge and support our charities. As of today, it's a main source of charity support for the Lodge.

In the past four years, Bingo has contributed \$98,107 dollars to various charities. Over 85% of the income generated by Bingo games goes to charities. All of this is possible because five volunteers help 40 to 60 people have fun on Monday night.

It all starts with player buying "cards" to play. We play 12 games using eight Bingo sheets. Each sheet has three Bingo cards on them and costs just \$2.00 per sheet. In addition, we run a game called Power Ball where a simple \$1.00 purchase can result in payouts ranging from \$50.00 to over \$1,000.00. Doors open at 5 p.m., card sales start at 6 p.m. with the games starting at 7 p.m. We are usually done by 9 p.m.

These five volunteers I mentioned above are tired of being here 48 weeks of the year. To this end, we have reduced the number of Monday nights by taking one week off every month and not playing Bingo. In addition, three of these volunteers will be taking vacation in September and, unless we get some more volunteers to come forth in August to be trained, we will not have Bingo at all. That brings up the BIG question.

Are there members of Tacoma Elks Lodge #174 willing to step up and support this activity which supports our charities? We need more than just players; we need volunteers to run the program. Without help from our members, this viable program, and our ability to support our community, will die. We have five weeks (not playing on August 17<sup>th</sup>) to have people trained and ready to run this valuable Lodge program. Are you willing to help save Bingo at Tacoma Lodge? Contact the Lodge Secretary and she will put you in touch with the Bingo committee.
