"WINNING" RECIPES



Super "Winning" Nachos

Nachos

1 lb. Hamburger

1 Large onion chopped

Salt to taste

Hot Sauce

1 or 2 Cans refried beans

1 4oz. can of whole chili's chopped

2-3 Cups of shredded Jack or Cheddar Cheese or mixed

3/4 Cup prepared taco sauce

8 Cups tortilla chips

Garnish

Chopped green onions

1 Cup of black olives sliced

1 Sliced avocado

1 Cup sour cream

Mild red pepper or a jalapeño pepper

Cilantro

Directions: Brown ground beef & onion. Drain off fat. Season with salt & hot sauce to taste (I use Frank's hot sauce or Tabasco sauce). *We like it spicy!*

Spread refried beans in a 9x13 glass serving dish spread evenly. Spread cheese, drizzle with taco sauce. (Cover and chill if made ahead.)

Bake at 400 degrees 20-30 minutes or until hot & heated through. Garnish quick with green onions and black olives. In the center mound the sliced avocado. Top with sour cream, red or jalapeño pepper. Sprinkle with cilantro. Tuck tortilla chips around the inside of the 9x13 dish. Keep warm on a warming tray. Serves 12-16. Delicious!



Crockpot Meatballs

2 2lb bags frozen meatballs

2 14 oz. cans cranberry sauce

2 12 oz. jars chili sauce

Directions: Place cranberry sauce and chili sauce in microwave safe bowl. Microwave for one minute. Stir. Mixure will be lumpy (as it cooks it becomes smooth).

Put frozen meatballs in the crockpot, pour sauce over meatballs. Cover and cook on low for 6-8 hours.
