### Boiler Upgrade

Thanks to a generous council grant, our new boiler has now been installed. We're currently reviewing heating control options to keep the centre warm through winter.

### Defibrillator

With the assistance of Comrie Centre funds, donations from the Comrie Community and support from St John's Scotland, we have purchased a community defibrillator. As the building is council-owned, installation must be completed by a council-approved electrician, paid for by the Comrie Centre. We are awaiting a quote and installation date.

### Planters

Our outdoor wooden planters have been replaced and will be freshly painted in the spring once the weather cooperates.

### Gardening Competition
