Morristown, NJ: Table of Hope, a program within the Spring Street Community Development Corporation is thrilled to announce a fun, new event for Morris County families. The Prom Free-Tique will be an interactive and exciting event where everything is at no cost so that students can attend their prom with pride.

The event will be held on March 25, 2023, at the Marion Sally Recreation Center at 23 Clyde Potts Avenue in Morristown from 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm.

The Free-Tique will offer a personalized browsing experience with timed entry sessions. Students and families will be able to peruse the offerings, try on and “say yes to the dress or suit” in a room filled with music and free raffles.

Collection is underway from now until March 18th for gently used prom dresses (long and short), suits, dress shirts, ties, dress shoes, evening bags, and costume jewelry. Clothing on hangers and with garment covers appreciated. Drop off is Monday to Friday from 8:00 am to 6 pm at 59 Spring Street, the basement of Bethel Church

Table of Hope is also seeking donations of the following: clothing racks, full length mirrors, garment wrappers, hangers, and reusable bags.

Businesses interested in providing gift cards for the free raffles are also welcome to become involved. Goods and services such as hair up dos and cuts, nails, make up, car service, jewelry, flowers and beauty products are sought for the free raffles.

Table of Hope is a place, “where hope starts, and the community gathers to share.” Close to 1,000 families in Morris County are served each week through the Mobile Food Pantry. As of December 2022, 42,000 families have been served through the Mobile Food Pantry and 17,000 individuals, seniors, families, and veterans were served through the community soup kitchen.
