RESOLUTION 2026-02

*A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the West Point Cemetery
District (District) Modifying District Bylaws*

Resolved by the Board of Directors of the District:

WHEREAS, the West Point Cemetery District is mandated under the law to maintain its properties for lawful burials of District residents or those who can demonstrate historical or familial ties to the West Point community; and,

WHEREAS, the District recognizes that unique circumstances may, on occasion, require solutions not anticipated under District Bylaws or approved burial guidelines and thus, require District Board approval;

Now, therefore the district resolves as follows:

- **To incorporate the attached language into the District Bylaws:**

SPECIAL AGREEMENTS

Section 1: Purpose

Nothing in these bylaws shall be construed as limiting the **Board of Trustees** from entering into special agreements with interment rights holders regarding non-standard plot maintenance, unique memorialization, or special interment arrangements, provided such agreements do not conflict with state law or jeopardize the district's operational capacity.

Section 2: Scope of Agreements

At the discretion of the Board of Trustees, the District may enter into written agreements that deviate from standard **Rules and Regulations** regarding:

Unique Memorials: Non-standard monument materials, sizes, or designs.

Specialized Landscaping: Specific plantings, borders, or non-standard turf alternatives on or around grave sites.

Non-Standard Interments: Specific requests for multiple cremains placements, natural burials, or other unique interment methods.

Section 3: Conditions & Requirements

All special agreements must adhere to the following conditions:

Written Contract: The agreement must be formalized in a written contract signed by the authorized **District representative** and the interment rights holder.

Endowment & Maintenance: The rights holder must pay all costs associated with the special request, including the funding of an adequate **Endowment Care trust** to cover any anticipated excess long-term maintenance required by the agreement.

Board Approval: The agreement must be approved by a majority vote of the Board of Trustees during a public meeting.

Safety & Access: The agreement must not impede the safety of visitors or the **ingress/egress** of District personnel and funeral equipment.

Section 4: District Rights & Liability

Revocation for Cause: The District reserves the right to modify or terminate the special agreement and restore the plot to standard conditions if the rights holder fails to maintain the agreed-upon standards or if the site deteriorates to a condition that poses a hazard or administrative burden.

Indemnification: The rights holder agrees to indemnify and hold the **West Point Cemetery District**, its Board, and its personnel harmless from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising directly or indirectly from the special agreement.

This Resolution is hereby adopted and approved by the Board of Trustees of the West Point Cemetery District.


