

SPRING PERFORMANCE INFORMATION: MAY 18-23

Hi JGNW Families,

Happy Spring! Here at JGNW we are winding down our team's 2026 competitive season. For us, that means next on the list is our Preschool and Recreation Spring Performances. Your kids have been working so hard and doing so great learning new and fun gymnastics skills. We are certain they can't wait to show you all they have been working on. This is what our Spring Performances are all about. You get to come into the gym and watch firsthand all the cool things they have been learning!

If your child attended our Winter Performance, then you know all the kids just did one routine on each of the 4 main pieces of apparatus. For the Spring Performance, we have a "gymnastics extravaganza". We highlight four skills the kids have been working on each of the 4 apparatus. They get to show you how awesome they are doing on each spot, as many times as they like, until we switch. It is very busy with tons of gymnastics and lots of fun for the kids!

The performance is not mandatory, but all kids who want to attend can. They do not need to be in class for a certain amount of time to be able to participate. Any kid of any level will be able to demonstrate their progress. The kids, although sometimes nervous at first, love attending these events and showing off their hard work.

Attending the performance costs \$20 per child. 2 spectators per child can attend and will be allowed inside the gym to watch the performance! Your child will receive an award at the end. You do not have to pre-sign up or pay ahead, we will just charge your card on file if they attend the performance. In addition to the performance, they will have an opportunity to attend a make-up class (whether they attend the performance or not). We will be offering a few make-up class options after the day's performances are over. Simply check the attached schedule to see when the make-up class options are being held.

As with all events we do in the gym, the Spring Performance causes quite a challenge with keeping a schedule that works for everyone and lets the kids still have a make-up class. Please pay close attention to the schedule listed below!

We understand the schedule during performance week can be a bit confusing so if you have questions please ask. We want to help however we can so your child can have the best possible experience.
