

Hi JGNW Families,

First off, we want to thank all our families for having your child enrolled in a fun, healthy activity with us! For all our families, new and old, we appreciate your support, and we hope you have enjoyed watching your child grow in their gymnastics with us!

It is also almost time for our Winter Performance! Your kids have been working hard all year long on different skills and events, so they are ready to show off!

You might be wondering, “What is the Winter Performance?” We will address that and our holiday closures in this newsletter! Please read carefully!

First, for our holiday closures.

- We are closed November 27-30 | Classes resume on Monday, December 1st
- We are closed December 24 - January 1 | Classes resume on Friday, January 2nd
- There are no make-up classes for holiday closures!
- **NO OPEN GYM NOVEMBER 29TH or DECEMBER 13th, 20th, and 27TH**

Please keep in mind that we do not offer make-up classes for closures due to the holidays. Some months you will get 5 weeks of class instead of 4, which evens out over the year.

Second, for our Winter Performance

Each year we do two “performances,” one before the New Year and the other before summer begins. These performances are a chance for you to come into the gym and see firsthand what your kids have been working on and how they are improving. This is not like a gymnastics competition or a dance recital. The kids do not work for months to do this one event. Instead, we simply highlight some of the things the kids have been working on and let them show them off. There are no “requirements” or amount of time the kids need to be in class for them to participate in these events. These events are for fun, and the kids love to do them!

Things to know about the Winter Performance:

- It is optional to attend.
- It costs \$20 per child (we bill the card you use for tuition).
- It should take approximately 90 minutes.
- The kids will receive an award for participating.
- We only allow 2 adults per child to attend the performance (our space is very limited).
- We will offer make-up classes due to the changes during performance week.
- Please do not have your kids do a make-up class the same day as their performance.
- If you absolutely cannot make their scheduled performance day and would like to do a different one, let us know via email. We may have space available.
- If your child attends class more than once a week, you can choose which performance day they attend, but not both.

The schedule for “Performance Week” can be a little crazy. Please read the schedule below carefully and if you have questions do not hesitate to ask. We are here to help!

Monday, Dec 15: NO REGULAR CLASSES **EXCEPT MORNING PRESCHOOL AT 9:00am**

- 5:30 – 7:00 Performance: Any kids who have regular class on **Monday at 3:00, Monday at 4:15, Monday at 5:30, Monday at 6:45, Thursday at 3:00, and Saturday at 10:00am** should attend this performance.
- **NO MAKE UP CLASS**

Tuesday, Dec 16: NO REGULAR CLASSES

- 5:30 – 7:00 Performance: Any kids who have regular class on **Monday at 9:00am, Tuesday at 3:00, Tuesday at 4:30, Tuesday at 7:00, Thursday at 4:00, Friday at 5:30, and Friday at 6:30** should attend this performance.
- 7:00 – 8:00 Make up class for any level Preschool, Rec, or Pre/Dev Team kids

Wednesday, Dec 17: NO REGULAR CLASSES

- 5:30 – 7:00 Performance: Any kids who have regular class on **Wednesday at 3:00, Wednesday at 4:30, Wednesday at 5:30, Thursday at 5:30, Thursday at 6:30, and Saturday at 11:00am** should attend this performance.
- **NO MAKE UP CLASS**

Thursday, Dec 18: NO REGULAR CLASSES

- 5:30 – 7:00 Performance: **ALL DEV/PRE-TEAM** and kids who have regular class on **Tuesday at 5:30, Wednesday at 4:00 (BOYS), and Wednesday at 6:30** should attend this performance.
- 7:00 – 8:00 Make up class for any level Preschool, Rec, or Pre/Dev Team kids

Friday, Dec 19: NO REGULAR CLASSES

- **No regular classes**

Saturday, Dec 20: NO REGULAR CLASSES

- **No regular classes OR open gym**
