- To maintain the balance between mentor mentee ratio so that optimum excellence be brought about in the education the college has filled up new four posts of the teachers in the subject of Social Work.
- The teachers conduct the lecture through different methods of teaching and use ICT tools. This helps the students to understand easily and enhance their interest in learning new and innovative things. The students have developed their ability to make presentation through power point, participate effectively in the group discussion, present their topics in the seminar. The college organizes different programmes, workshops, seminars for the students and many times the students conduct the programmes and participate actively. - In the Research area the students have become proficient. As per the curriculum of BSW and MSW the students have to do Mini-Research Project and Dissertation respectively. In the last three years more than three hundred students completed their research work and contributed to the knowledge.

- The students as per the curriculum conduct field work. The students directly approach the field and try to find out the problems of the society and do study for their solution. The students invite experts of the respective field to guide the people. The students by visiting different agencies, going on Study Tour Exposure visit at district, state level they enhance their knowledge of different renowned agencies, their working process which heighten their knowledge and help them to work confidently, skillfully and effectively.
- The students participate in different rallies which are conducted by the college, government for the awareness of the people. The students also have contributed in the government schemes by directly participating in those events as “Cleanliness Awareness” Internship programmes of government, “Election Awareness”.
