Understanding Faculties

(Because the bulletins were not delivered on the weekend of March 26+27, I am reprinting the article since it is an important issue.)



Being so close to the Wisconsin border presents a situation that I did not have to face when I was at my other parishes. I, Fr. Mike, and our four deacons, are ministers assigned to the Archdiocese of Chicago. We have faculties to minister in Cook and Lake Counties. If we go to a different diocese to do ministry we must have a letter of good standing from the Archdiocese of Chicago Chancery Office.

Recently, I was confronted with an issue that I had to explain. A parishioner was in a hospital in Kenosha Wisconsin and wanted to be anointed. I arranged for a priest from the Milwaukee Archdiocese to do the anointing. Unfortunately, a family member was upset that I did not go myself. I had to explain that a priest from Chicago does not have faculties in Milwaukee. The family member was not aware that this canonical rule existed, and I believe she was a bit angry at me. I do understand the anger and hurt, but it is actually a learning point that should be stressed to everyone. Simply put, priests and deacons do not have faculties outside of their Diocese. Again, a letter of good standing must be obtained if we wish to minister outside of our own Diocese (which is good for a single occasion, like a wedding or funeral).

This practice of having faculties (or responsibilities) in a certain area pertains to other areas in life. For example, a police officer from Antioch cannot go to Chicago and write speeding tickets. They are out of their area.

I had to work on a letter for Fr. Mike and I which will allow us to minister at the hospital in McHenry (this hospital is in the Rockford Diocese). The Archdiocese will issue a letter requesting faculties from the Bishop of Rockford granting us faculties, but this letter will have to be renewed on a yearly basis. Unfortunately, I was told by a person in the Office of Canonical Affairs that the Milwaukee Archdiocese should take care of any hospitals located in their Archdiocese. Kenosha is in Wisconsin and hospitals and nursing home facilities should be serviced by priests from that area.

To avoid future disappointment, please be aware that if you or a loved one is in a hospital or nursing home in Wisconsin, Fr. Mike and myself are not allowed to minister to you or your loved one. We can visit and say hello, but we do not have faculties in Milwaukee to do ministry. If you know that you are going to the hospital, please consider coming to the parish first to be anointed. If an anointing is needed in Kenosha, a priest from Milwaukee will be called in for the sacrament. What is important is the sacrament. Every Catholic Priest is an instrument of grace. Thank you for understanding.


