## From Pastor Fr. George Koeune

#### Bells at Mass

(Adapted from an article by Paul Turner, LTP Press)



When a priest shows the consecrated host and chalice to the people, the server may or may not ring a bell. It's an option. Some Catholic communities exercise it; others do not.

Bells have harmonized with church life since the sixth century, when they first summoned worshipers to church. In the early thirteenth century, the faithful were going to Communion so infrequently that the Church had to require it once a year. When they attended Mass, the faithful wanted to see the host. The priest, presiding in the same direction as the people (looking toward the Tabernacle), lifted the host during the recitation of the words of Jesus at the Last Supper so that the faithful who would not receive it could adore it. During the same century, the server started ringing the bell to let the people know the elevation had come.

Today when the priest shows the consecrated bread and chalice to the people, the ringing of the bell is optional. The bells during the Eucharistic Prayer no longer serve the purpose they did when they were introduced. They are permitted, but an assembly that prays attentively at Mass will not need them.

However, on a personal note, I enjoy hearing the bells. It harkens back to a tradition of drawing attention to the Holy Eucharist at Mass. For me, it illustrates how special The Body of Christ is to our spiritual lives. Still, the bells are optional, and whether they are used at Mass or not, The Holy Eucharist is always special.

#### Lake County Illinois Catholic Charities assistance programs

If you need help in Lake County Illinois, then Catholic Charities is one of the leading organizations to contact. They provide direct emergency assistance, referrals, and partner with non-profits and companies such as North Shore Gas. Social workers from Catholic Charities will advocate on your behalf, provide case management, and offer direct financial assistance if it is available.

Heating bill assistance is offered from the Heartship Program. Catholic Charities may have funds that can help North Shore Gas customers whose heating service has been shut off. Various hardship conditions need to be met, as well as income guidelines are in place. Call the agency at 847-782-4100 in order to apply for Heartship.

Housing and shelter is offered by the Samaritan House. This location caters to homeless women and children in Lake County. So short term housing is offered, as well as support and case management to help people end the cycle of homelessness. Once someone is stable. Catholic Charities will help facilitate longer term housing placement assistance as well as provide skills training. The goal is to also help someone find a job so they can pay the rent on their own in the future.

Some of the case management services provided by Samaritan House include employment and budget counseling, skills education, life skills development, and much more. Referrals are provided for other munity resources as well as state of Illinois and federal government public assistance programs. 847.782.4142

Rapid Re-housing Program, Housing Counseling and Case Management -This Catholic Charity program helps families locate and secure affordable, safe, and quality housing. Get assistance with developing workable budgets, communicating with prospective landlords, maintaining and paying for the housing, and get information on tenant's and homeowner rights and responsibilities. Foreclosure prevention and counseling may be provided too.

#### **Pentecost Sunday**

In today's Gospel Luke, the author of Acts, links the "time of Pentecost" to the Jewish Feast of Weeks. This was a harvest festival, fifty days after Passover. The feast became a celebration of God's gift of the Torah, the law of Moses, remembering Exodus 19. Luke suggests that just as the Feast of Weeks was a culmination of Passover, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit was a culmination of the Resurrection. In both Passover and Easter, God's extraordinary saving action rescued God's people from oppression and death. Because of these actions, the stage was set for the gift of Torah, and similarly for Christians, the gift of the Spirit. The ongoing presence of the Spirit sustains us to face life's burdens gracefully. The Spirit also challenges us daily to mature in our capacity to love, and to take part in God's ongoing work to rescue all God's people.

#### WHAT GOD IS UP TO

The Christian community gathered in the Upper Room, awaiting the Holy Spirit, has long stirred the Christian imagination. In our own time, when the Church has a long history of Christian faith but now faces many challenges, we might return to this image. Like the first disciples, we often don't know what to do next. What used to work for us doesn't work as well. We need to stay together, honor diversity, reflect upon the roots of our faith, and remain rooted in prayer.

Yet there is more. Pentecost has happened and is happening. The Spirit has already burst out into the world, already stirring among those who are confused about God. The Book of Acts tells the story of a Church continually pushed out by the Spirit, to join in what God was already up to, out in the world. We too are invited not only to remember our unity and our roots, but to pay acute attention to how the Spirit is working in our local communities.

#### **VARIETY OF GIFTS**

In today's second reading, Saint Paul wrote to the Church in Corinth, a community encountering tensions and divisions over spiritual gifts. Paul reminds them that the Spirit shares a variety of gifts; none is better than any other, and all are needed by the whole Church. The Spirit is revealed in the diversity of gifts offered by individuals and by distinct groups. The Spirit desires that the Church live as an interdependent, cohesive whole, as the Body of Christ.

A parish can be a collegial partnership where parishioners, clergy, and ministry staff can confidently share God's gifts. Gifts from persons and groups of diverse backgrounds can be honored. Gifts that tend to be less visible, such as in finance, custodial work, or administration, can be celebrated as much as those in preaching and music. May we notice God's grace in this diversity.
