Freedom and Respect



On Monday we celebrate the 4th of July, the civil holiday which commemorates the signing of the Declaration of Independence. It's a day in which we celebrate our release from a foreign government, and the start of the United States as a self-governing nation.

Many of us probably think about fireworks when we think of the 4th of July. The exploding lights in the sky remind us of our freedom. I have always enjoyed a good fireworks display, and I believe independence is something that should be celebrated, however, a fireworks display should be done in a specified location by a community that can legally and safely run such an event. Many people are injured every year, some quite seriously, by being careless with fireworks. It is unfortunate that such a wonderful holiday is too often marred by reckless behavior. Years ago, a parishioner at my former parish lost his uncle when he put his face too close to a rocket that had a delayed take off. This tragedy could have been avoided if the man would have remembered how powerful fireworks are and what they are capable of doing. Many fireworks made today explode with a force that can cause serious injury (even death). Freedom is something to be celebrated, but it should be done with respect, and always with safety in mind.

While not as important as human life, it should be noted that property too should be respected. At my last parish there were times when the property around the Church was not treated with the holiness and respect it deserved. I consider every parish to be holy ground. Destruction of property, shooting off fireworks on Church land, gathering in the parking lot as if it were a nightclub where you drink and throw beer bottles, all these types of activities show a real disrespect for Our Lord Jesus Christ. Such behavior is not a celebration of the spirit of the 4th of July.

Let us celebrate our wonderful day of independence, but, let us always remember that freedom must include respect for others. As you enjoy the 4th of July, please be careful around fireworks. Every year I hear stories about someone getting hurt. I hate to hear such news. Please enjoy the holiday, but please be careful.

Lake County Illinois Catholic Charities assistance programs

If you need help in Lake County Illinois, then Catholic Charities is one of the leading organizations to contact. They provide direct emergency assistance, referrals, and partner with non-profits and companies such as North Shore Gas. Social workers from Catholic Charities will advocate on your behalf, provide case management, and offer direct financial assistance if it is available.

Heating bill assistance is offered from the **Heartship Program**. Catholic Charities may have funds that can help North Shore Gas customers whose heating service has been shut off. Various hardship conditions need to be met, as well as income guidelines are in place. Call the agency at 847-782-4100 in order to apply for Heartship.

Housing and shelter is offered by the Samaritan House. This location caters to homeless women and children in Lake County. So short term housing is offered, as well as support and case management to help people end the cycle of homelessness. Once someone is stable, Catholic Charities will help facilitate longer term housing placement assistance as well as provide skills training. The goal is to also help someone find a job so they can pay the rent on their own in the future.

Some of the case management services provided by Samaritan House include employment and budget counseling, skills education, life skills development, and much more. Referrals are provided for other community resources as well as state of Illinois and federal government public assistance programs. 847.782.4142

Rapid Re-housing Program, Housing Counseling and Case Management -This Catholic Charity program helps families locate and secure affordable, safe, and quality housing. Get assistance with developing workable budgets, communicating with prospective landlords, maintaining and paying for the housing, and get information on tenant's and homeowner rights and responsibilities. Foreclosure prevention and counseling may be provided too.


