Our Lady of the Lakes St. Bede School

Dear St. Bede School Community,

I am excited to introduce myself to you as the new interim principal for St. Bede School.

I come to you with over 40 years' experience in Catholic education. The majority of those years, 34 to be exact, were at Carmel Catholic High School where I began as an English teacher and where I spent the last 14 years as an administrator, first as Assistant Principal and then as the first lay Principal. Since retiring, I have done work with the Archdiocese of Chicago as a consultant where I assisted in parish faith formation program organization, mentored new school principals, conducted professional development workshops and assisted where needed as an interim principal. This brought me to St. Joseph School in Libertyville and a few years later to St. Mary School in Buffalo Grove.

I am a product of Catholic education myself, as are my three children and my six grandchildren. These personal encounters, along with my career involvement over these many years, have resulted in the fact that I am a believer, a cheerleader for Catholic education. Be prepared to hear me sing the praises whenever given the opportunity.

A higher level of academic success is a given, just look at the data which shows that graduates of Catholic schools accelerate nationally over the public sector. However, the real story of success lies in the fact that Catholic schools, like St. Bede's, provide what can't be given in public schools -holistic education. This means that in addition to academic, social and physical development, Catholic schools can focus on spiritual development, values education, and therein lies all the difference. In a New York Post article they refer to it as "The 'secret sauce' that helps Catholic schools over-achieve". (Jan. 26, 2020) In this day and age, children are pulled in all directions, social media inundates them with messaging that causes confusion and self-doubt, The greatest internal struggle in children is a lack of self-worth. Spiritual development allows them to get acquainted with a God who loves them unconditionally and who walks with them through joy and sorrow - they are never alone. This same God has blessed them with uniqueness which is the gift they bring into the world that will have an impact. This knowledge has a tremendous impact. I have seen it over and over again. Even Aristotle agrees, he said: "Educating the mind without educating the heart is no education at all."

The strength of the messaging is delivered throughout the program by teachers and staff who understand that their role is a vocation, not merely a job. They understand that they do God's work in educating the children entrusted to them and have chosen to dedicate their lives in response to God's call. We understand that the children are the top priority in all that we do, in all the ways we act. Let me tell you - that makes all the difference. I warned you I was a cheerleader.

I look forward to the joy of beginning this new year and to meeting each of you. I ask that we pray as a community:

We ask you to energize and renew us.
Fill us with the spirit of wonder,
enchanted and delighted with opening minds and hearts,
ready to take on the challenge of growth and change

Lake County Illinois Catholic Charities assistance programs

If you need help in Lake County Illinois, then Catholic Charities is one of the leading organizations to contact. They provide direct emergency assistance, referrals, and partner with non-profits and companies such as North Shore Gas. Social workers from Catholic Charities will advocate on your behalf, provide case management, and offer direct financial assistance if it is available.

Heating bill assistance is offered from the Heartship Program. Catholic Charities may have funds that can help North Shore Gas customers whose heating service has been shut off. Various hardship conditions need to be met, as well as income guidelines are in place. Call the agency at 847-782-4100 in order to apply for Heartship.

Housing and shelter is offered by the Samaritan House. This location caters to homeless women and children in Lake County. So short term housing is offered, as well as support and case management to help people end the cycle of homelessness. Once someone is stable, Catholic Charities will help facilitate longer term housing placement assistance as well as provide skills training. The goal is to also help someone find a job so they can pay the rent on their own in the future.

Some of the case management services provided by Samaritan House include employment and budget counseling, skills education, life skills development, and much more. Referrals are provided for other community resources as well as state of Illinois and federal government public assistance programs. 847.782.4142

Rapid Re-housing Program, Housing Counseling and Case Management -This Catholic Charity program helps families locate and secure affordable, safe, and quality housing. Get assistance with developing workable budgets, communicating with prospective landlords, maintaining and paying for the housing, and get information on tenant's and homeowner rights and responsibilities. Foreclosure prevention and counseling may be provided too.


