From Pastor Fr. George Koeune

Please Help!

We have been through a lot with the pandemic. Thankfully our churches are open and we are getting back to normal with regards to our liturgies. Unfortunately, we are in desperate need of Ushers and Eucharistic Ministers to help cover all our weekend Masses. Some of our liturgies are well covered, but some often have no one assigned to help. Just two weeks ago I had to ask for help since no one was taking up the collection at the Mass. I have also had to ask for Eucharistic Ministers to come forward to help at a Mass when I was by myself.

It would make our liturgies flow so much better if parishioners would be willing to cover the Mass they attend. For the most part we have not had too much difficulty getting people to help distribute Holy Eucharist, but we have had quite a problem getting people to be Ushers at Mass.

One of the main jobs of an Usher is to take up the collection. However, an Usher's role is more than a collector of envelopes and money. An Usher greets people, guides them to pews, answers questions, and responds to emergency situations which occur in church. When a person falls ill, it is the duty of an Usher to call for an ambulance if the need arises. When the ambulance arrives, the Usher directs the paramedics to the sick person. An Usher oversees the needs of the congregation, and as a Presider, I am grateful for the ministry they perform. They put my mind at ease so I can focus on my liturgical role as Presider.

We need more Ushers! If you are a friendly man or woman willing to assist in this important ministry, please contact Ms. Becky Serna at the parish office to sign up to help. We need people to help take care of God's House.

I am most grateful that we have so many people who feel called to minister at Our Lady of The Lakes Parish. Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, those involved in singing, decorating, cleaning our church, and many other ministries, make our liturgies truly prayerful. Please consider helping us as we go forward from the restrictions that were placed upon us during the pandemic.





Sacramental Policies

In accordance with the policies of the Archdiocese of Chicago it is required that all children have a minimum of two continuous years of preparation before receiving a sacrament. Here at Our Lady Of The Lakes, that means those seeking Reconciliation and First Communion are asked to attend both First and Second Grade classes in either our school or religious education programs. Those seeking Confirmation are likewise asked to attend both seventh and eighth grade before receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. The Legion of Mary **Pilgrim Virgin Statue Home Visitation Program**



What is the Legion of Mary?

The Legion of Mary is the largest lay apostolic organization of faithful Catholics united under the banner and protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Influenced by the Holy Spirit, and Divine Grace, the members serve the Church and Their neighbors, for the Glory of God by prayer and active co-operation with our Blessed Mother's desire to bring Christ to Souls and Souls to Christ.

What is the Pilgrim Virgin Statue Home Visitation Program?

The Pilgrim Virgin Statue is a Blessed 20" tall replica of our Lady of Fatima. It is a traveling sacramental offered by the Legion of Mary, Our Lady of Grace Praesidium, for visitation in your residence to create a prayerful, sanctifying space where family and friends are encouraged to pray the Rosary and mediate on its mysteries.

How does the program work?

Lake County Illinois Catholic Charities assistance programs

If you need help in Lake County Illinois, then Catholic Charities is one of the leading organizations to contact. They provide direct emergency assistance, referrals, and partner with non-profits and companies such as North Shore Gas. Social workers from Catholic Charities will advocate on your behalf, provide case management, and offer direct financial assistance if it is available.

Heating bill assistance is offered from the **Heartship Program**. Catholic Charities may have funds that can help North Shore Gas customers whose heating service has been shut off. Various hardship conditions need to be met, as well as income guidelines are in place. Call the agency at 847-782-4100 in order to apply for Heartship.

Housing and shelter is offered by the Samaritan House. This location caters to homeless women and children in Lake County. So short term housing is offered, as well as support and case management to help people end the cycle of homelessness. Once someone is stable, Catholic Charities will help facilitate longer term housing placement assistance as well as provide skills training. The goal is to also help someone find a job so they can pay the rent on their own in the future.

Some of the case management services provided by Samaritan House include employment and budget counseling, skills education, life skills development, and much more. Referrals are provided for other community resources as well as state of Illinois and federal government public assistance programs. 847.782.4142

Rapid Re-housing Program, Housing Counseling and Case

Management - This Catholic Charity program helps families locate and secure affordable, safe, and quality housing. Get assistance with developing workable budgets, communicating with prospective landlords, maintaining and paying for the housing, and get information on tenant's and homeowner rights and responsibilities. Foreclosure prevention and counseling may be provided too.

Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel is a sequel to last week's account of Jesus feeding a large crowd with five barley loves and a few fish. Here, Jesus is challenging the crowd to see in the bread they have eaten a sign of God's generosity in providing for all the blessings in their lives, as well as the blessing of life itself. The first reading, from Exodus, recounts how the escaped Hebrew slaves were fed in the wilderness, first with quail, then with manna. The psalm is a later reflection on the manna as the bread from heaven and a blessing from God. The selection from the letter to the Ephesians sketches the image of putting away the "old self" and putting on the new, emphasizing that a person's life in Christ needs to differ from their previous life, just as the life of a free person differs from that of a slave.

SIGNS AND WONDERS?

Today's Gospel continues into a second day the narrative that had begun the day before when, after crossing the lake to look for Jesus, a large crowd are fed with five barley loaves and two fish. The following day (today's reading), after more lake crossings, the people who had been miraculously fed are again searching for Jesus. However, they do so (as Jesus puts it) "not because you saw signs, but because you ate the loaves and were filled" (John 6:6).

In John's Gospel, the word "sign" has a distinct meaning. At the wedding at Cana, after telling how Jesus turned water into wine, the Evangelist notes "Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs" that "revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him" (John 2:11). For John, signs are not just wonders to behold; they are about the revelation of God and a response of faith in Jesus.

OR MAYBE THE SIGN IS THE WONDER

When the crowd first arrives, Jesus notes that they had not appreciated the sign that he had already given; they are still focused on their physical hunger. When they ask for a sign, "that we may see and believe in you" (John 6:30), they refer to their ancestors who ate manna in the wilderness. Can Jesus top that? Can he give them more bread that will relieve them of their daily worries about going hungry?

Jesus reminds the crowd that it was not Moses who gave the "bread from heaven," but his Father. Further, the Father can give them the true bread from heaven that comes down and gives life to the world. There is a parallel in the Greek between working for food that perishes and doing the works of God, which is believing in Jesus as the one God has sent. This is the sign that the people missed the day before, the sign that Jesus is pointing out to them.

Like the Evangelist, the Church uses the word "sign" for its sacraments. Like the crowd, we are called to see similar "signs" of God's generosity in all the blessings of our lives.
