Respect Life Month

October is Respect Life month. During this month many people will offer prayers for an end to the sin of abortion and euthanasia (prayers which are greatly needed), however, respect life calls for an end to all violence and abuse.

This is an old study, but back in 2008 the Chicago Police Department Crime Statistics reported that 9.5% of murders in Chicago were attributed to domestic violence. It is frightening to think that almost 10% of the murders in Chicago took place in the home. The home is meant to be a safe place. Family members are called to love and cherish each other. It saddens me to think that physical, mental, sexual, emotional, and verbal abuse occurs between people who are spouses, parents, and children to one another. The United States Bishops document - *When I Call For Help* - states that “*violence against another person in any form fails to treat that person as someone worthy of love. Instead, it treats the person as an object to be used.*” People must not be treated like objects. It is wrong to use or try to control someone. A person who uses another for personal gain is a very small and selfish person who is going against the love of God.

In the 1990's, researchers discovered that domestic violence rose during major sporting events and holidays. We are in the midst of the football season (although this year it is a bit different since the games are not being attended by fans) and are quickly approaching Thanksgiving Day and Christmas. Statistics show that violence in the home will rise. If you, or someone you know, needs immediate assistance, anyone in Illinois may call the **Lake County Crisis Center For The Prevention & Treatment Of Domestic Violence, Inc. at (847) 249-4450.**

During this Respect Life month let us pray that people everywhere will respect life from conception until natural death. Let us pray that the sin of abortion, the sin of euthanasia, and all other sins of violence will be replaced with love and respect.

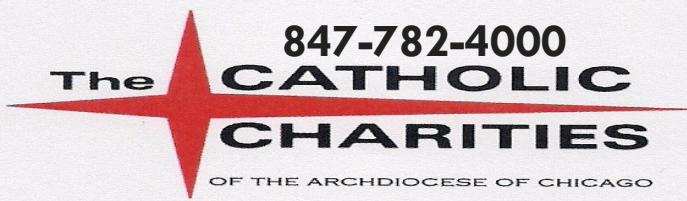

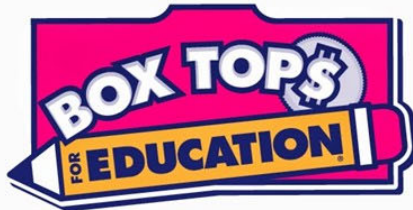

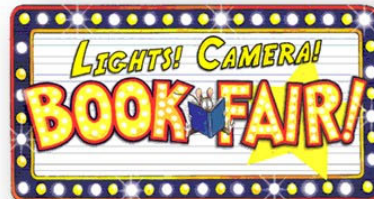
BOOK FAIR - OCTOBER 25-29!
