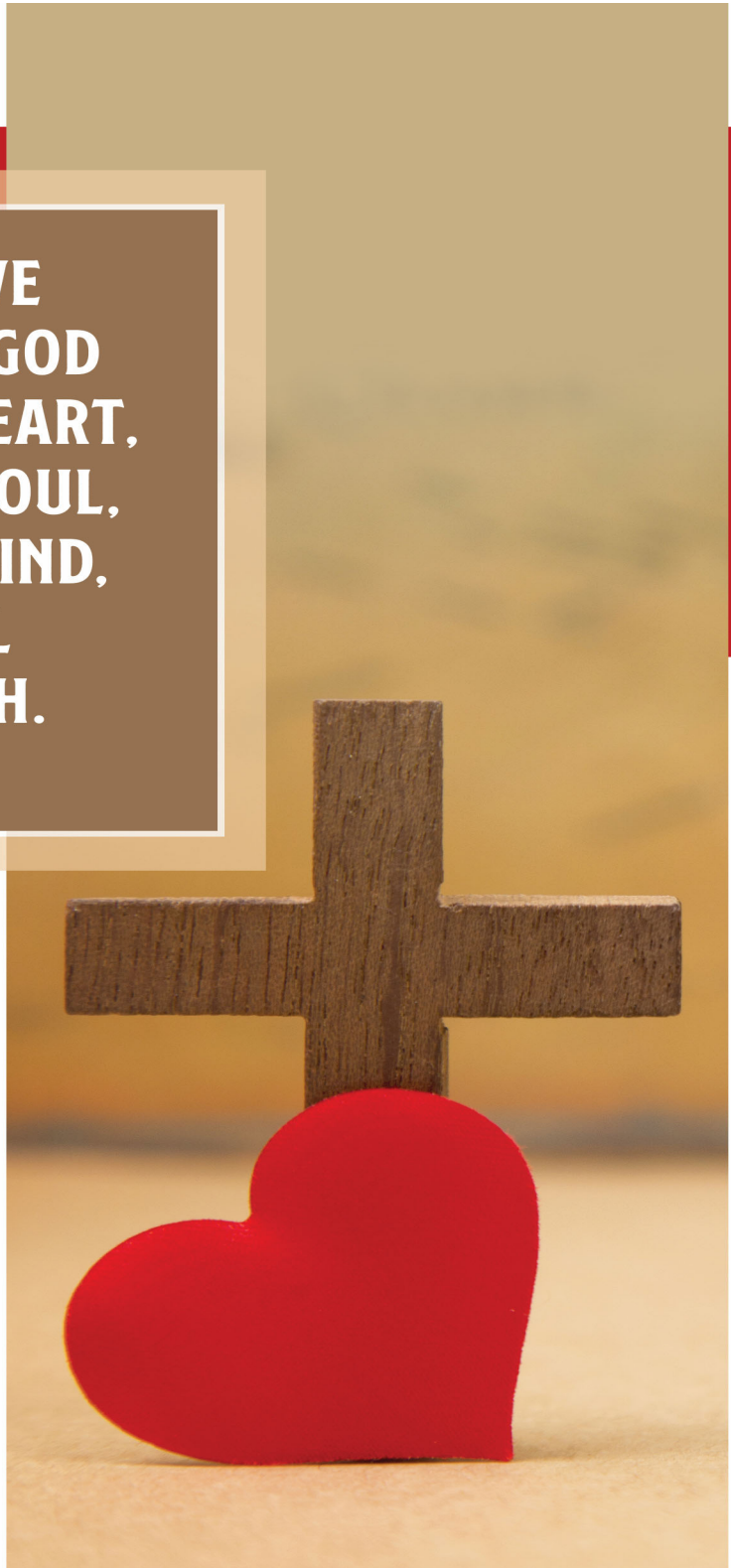

Halloween (A Holy Night)

As we near the end of the month of October, the daylight has been growing shorter and the days are getting colder. As the world seems to be falling asleep, the Catholic Church celebrates some great feast days - All Saints and All Souls, the first and second days of November. An old name for All Saints Day was All Hallowmas ("Hallow" is another word for Saint). Years ago, the evening of All Saints Day was called All Hallows' Eve, which got shortened to Halloween (from Hallowe'en, i.e., Hallows evening).

Halloween, as it is called today, has an interesting history. In the past, many peoples of northern Europe divided the year into four seasons based on the length of days. Their seasons were a bit different than ours, but they were very similar. Winter was the period of the shortest days. It began on November 1st, and ended on February 1st. On October 31st, huge bonfires were lit on hilltops. They did this because they believed the dead would return home on this night and they wanted to make them feel warm and comfortable. Food was set out to make them feel welcomed. Any stranger who came to the door was welcomed into the home. Who knew? Maybe the stranger was really a dead relative!

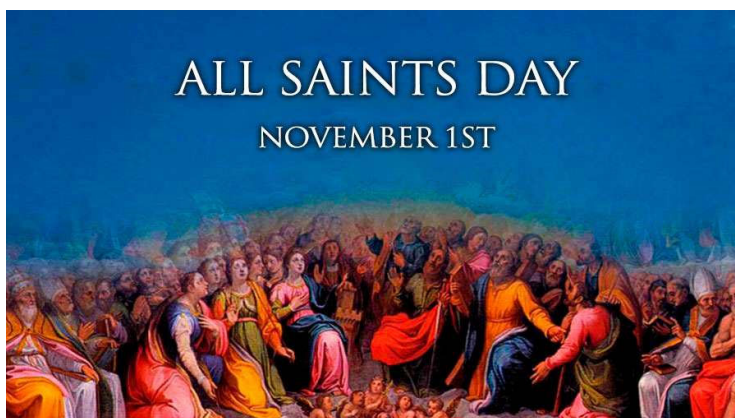
But the annual return of dead loving relatives was not always joyful, for some of them were not friendly. So, everyone would stay together on the night of October 31st for protection. They would gather around bonfires and tell stories of the dead and of narrow escapes from cranky ghosts. People would dress up like the dead to make any ghostly visitors feel more welcomed and to confuse any angry ones.

In the earliest days of our faith, the remembrance of the dead and the celebration of the Saints took place around Easter. However, in the tenth century in western Europe, the Catholic Church began to keep the remembrance of the dead in November, when the earth itself seemed to be dying.

Today, in most of Europe, Halloween is strictly a religious event. In the United States the Church's traditions are lost or confused. Still, All Hallows Eve has been kept by the church for more than one thousand years. Halloween night can still be a holy night. Halloween customs reflect the gospel. Trick-or-treat is good, old-fashioned hospitality. In the name of Christ we welcome all who knock on our doors, and we share food with them. Walking around in masks reminds us of our journey to heaven. Once our journey is done, the masks must be removed, and then we will see ourselves as we truly are - the beloved children of God, the Saints in glory.

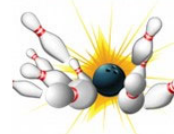

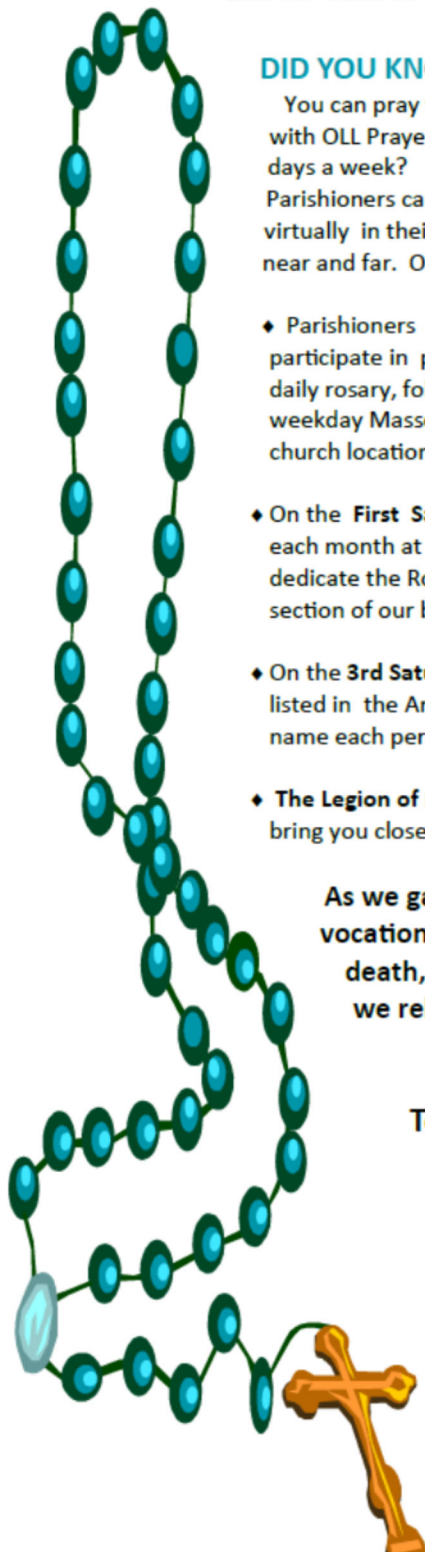
You can pray the rosary with OLL Prayer Warriors six days a week?

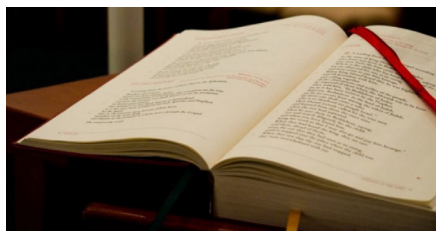

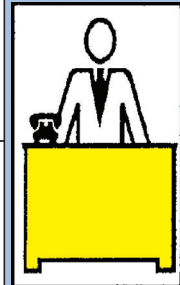

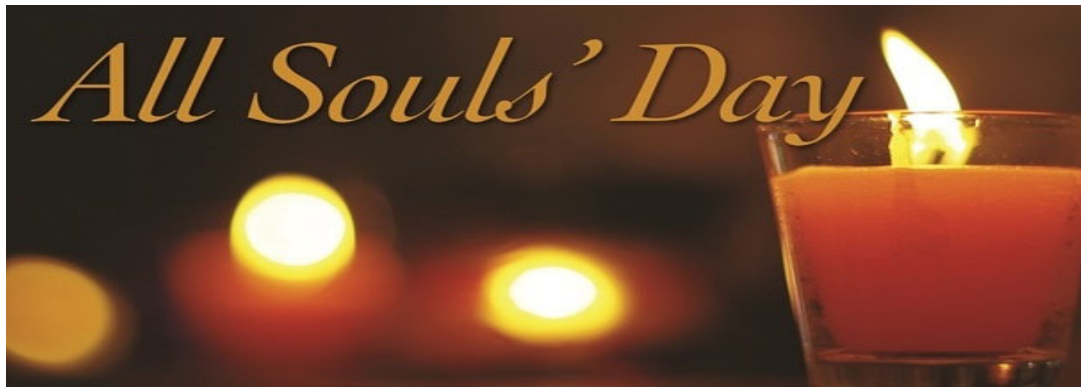
