## What is CRSC Pay?

### CRSC PAY EXPLAINED

Combat-Related Special Compensation (CRSC) is a monthly tax-free benefit starting at a disability rating of 10% for retired Veterans who have combat-related injuries. CRSC can only be rewarded to Veterans who retired with their branch of service and have a documented combat-related injury. The amount awarded is typically equal to or less than the length of service, retirement pay, and VA disability compensation.

### YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE IF

If you're retired and receiving or entitled to military retirement pay with a VA disability rating of **ATLEAST 10%** and your current DoD retirement payments are reduced by the amount of your VA disability payments.

In addition, you must have served 20+ years of service, or retired for medical reasons with a disability rating of at least 30%, or you must have coverage under either TERA, TDRL, or PDRL.

### HOW TO APPLY

Follow the link ([Click Here](#)) and download necessary application forms and gather all necessary evidence of your combat-related disability. Create copies of the original documents and send the copies to your uniform services for a decision.

## What is CRDP Pay?

### YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE IF

If you're retired with the reserves OR regular military and receiving or entitled to military retirement pay with a VA disability rating of ATLEAST 50%.

Additionally, you cannot be receiving retirement pay based on disability.

### HOW TO APPLY

Applying for CRDP is not necessary as enrollment is automatic.

### WHO WOULD BENEFIT FROM THIS?

A military retiree who has not received their disability, never claimed their disability, or as they aged their disability worsened.

### CRDP PAY EXPLAINED

Concurrent Retirement and Disability Pay (CRDP) is a monthly disability benefit starting at a rating of 50% for retired Veterans who have combat-related injuries. If you are retired without a disability rating, just to receive one year or months later, you will also be eligible for retroactive payments which can go back as far as your retirement date.

# CRSC VS. CRDP

## CRSC

Disability rating of 10% or higher

Must be a retired Military member

Have served 20+ years in Military

National Guard eligible

Application necessary

Retroactive payments eligible

Tax Free

Receives an adjusted amount

Medical retirement eligible at 30%

## CRDP

Disability rating of 50% or higher

Must be a retired Military member

Have served 20+ years in Military

National Guard NOT eligible

Automatic enrollment

Retroactive payments eligible

Receives BOTH retired pay and VA compensation

Disability rating of 50% or higher

Medical retirement NOT eligible
