



## MILITARY SERVICE RECORDS REQUESTS

### WHAT TO KNOW

Military records, in particular, service treatment records (STRs) are a vital resource used during the VA claims to prove and can often be the key to providing the necessary evidence needed to establish the service connection for your disability.

Both options provide medical history, feel free to follow-up with us if you have any questions.

Once received do not forget to carefully review your service treatment record to ensure it contains a proper chronological record of all medical, dental, and psychiatric care received while on active duty.



#### PROCESSING TIME & CHECKING YOUR STATUS

Times vary, but give approximately 90 days before submitting a follow-up. In order to check your status you will need your service request number.



#### WHO CAN MAKE A REQUEST?

Only the Veteran or next-of-kin can request service records.



#### WHAT YOU NEED FOR A REQUEST

1. Full name at the time of service
2. Place of birth
3. Date of birth
4. Your service number
5. Social security number
6. Branch of service
7. Dates of service
