THE APPEALS PROCESS

FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE VA:

The decision process has changed, effective February 19, 2019. If you would like to appeal a decision made before February 19th, 2019, you will follow the legacy steps with the VA.

Common Reasons for a VA Appeal:

- The VA has denied your disability benefits claim.
- You believe your disability is service related.
- You believe your disability is more severe than what the VA rated it.

VA REVIEWS YOUR CASE:

At this point in the process all supplemental evidence and material will be reviewed by the VA. This process can take anywhere from 12 months to 7 years, once the VA has made a decision, you will be notified.

YOU RECEIVE YOUR CASE DECISION:

If you are satisfied with the decision made, you can move forward with collecting your benefits. If you are no satisfied, you can now file another appeal.
