Clifton has been called one of the “100 best small art towns in America,” and we’re going to find out why! Constructed in the late-1800s, **Our Savior's Lutheran Church** is a true treasure of the Norwegian settlement in Bosque County. As the congregation grew, a second church, St. Olaf Kirke, commonly referred to as **The Rock Church**, was built in 1885 just six miles down the road. Enjoy a traditional **Norwegian lunch** served by the wonderful volunteers at Trinity Lutheran before we explore the **Bosque Museum** and the **Bosque Art Center**, one of the finest community art complexes in the state. Lastly, **The CLIFTEX Theatre** is Texas' oldest, continuously operating movie theater, and has been showing movies in Clifton since 1916.
