

BACKGROUND

More than 800 Needham residents have signed the Safer Quieter Needham petition. The SQN petition expresses support for improving safety at Needham's six railroad crossings while eliminating non-emergency train horns and maintaining full commuter rail service throughout Needham.

As hard as it is to believe, according to the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA), as of May 2021 the collision risk at Needham's road crossings is 40% worse than the national average. 40% worse!

Establishing a Quiet Zone requires installing Supplemental Safety Measures (SSMs) at each crossing. Installing the minimum required SSMs would improve the collision risk at Needham's road crossings to 40% better than the national average.

This represents a significant improvement we should want to make as a community regardless of the train horn issue. And the punishingly loud train horns have a significant and meaningful impact to the quality of life and mental health of thousands of Needham children, seniors, families, and residents.
